The chapter officers for 1949-50 were Roy Johnson, president; Clarence Lydic, vice-president, Dick Messick, secretary, Jerry Williams, reporter, Sam Openshaw, sentinel; and Mr. V.G LaTourette, sponsor. The yearbook described a busy year of involvement in the State Fair, participation in various livestock judging contests, and a big win at the Federation Parliamentary Practices Meeting at the North Side Federation. The year ended with the annual May "fishing trip."

In 1953, Bob Moore was elected State FFA President.
