Timeline of the 1970s

• April 1970	For the first time the U.S. census counted over 200 million people living in the country.
• May 1970	In a Vietnam protest, at Kent State University, four people were killed and nine people were wounded.
• January 1971	A ban on television advertisements for cigarettes goes into effect in the United States.
• March 1971	The 26 th Amendment was passed changing the voting age from 21 to 18.
• June 1971	The Supreme Court allowed the New York Times and Washington Post to publish the Pentagon papers.
• October 1971	Disneyland opens up on the east coast in Orlando.
• March 1972	The United States in retaliation for North Vietnamese troops crossing into South Vietnam began bombing Hanoi and Haiphong.
• May 1972	President Nixon agrees to a strategic arms pact with the Soviet Union. This was known as SALT I.
• June 1972	The Watergate crisis begins with the arrest of four men for breaking into the Democratic National Committee offices.
• November 1972	President Nixon wins re-election over George McGovern by a landslide of 520 electoral votes to 17.
• January 1973	The Supreme Court in Wade versus Roe rules that a woman can not be prevented from having an abortion in the first six months of pregnancy.
• January 1973	The Paris Peace Accords end the Vietnam War. At the same time, the military draft was ended.

Secretariat wins the Belmont Stakes by 37 lengths to win the Triple Crown in one of the most dominant displays in horse racing history. October 1973 Vice President Spiro Agnew resigns among charges of tax evasion. He is replaced as Vice President by Gerald Ford. May 1974 Impeachment hearings begin against President Nixon as a result of the Watergate Affair. August 1974 President Nixon becomes the first president to ever resign from office. He is replaced by Vice President Gerald Ford. **January 1975** The show Wheel of Fortune premieres. **April 1975** The communists capture Saigon and take over all of Vietnam. September 1975 Patty Hearst, heiress of the Hearst fortune, is rescued after her year of being held captive by the Symbionese Liberation Army and participating in a robbery in California. **July 1976** Viking I a space probe successfully lands on the surface of Mars. November 1976 Jimmy Carter, a relatively unknown governor from Georgia, wins the Presidential election over Gerald Ford by an electoral count of 297 - 240.January 1977 The majority of Vietnam War draft evaders, 10,000 in number, are pardoned by President Jimmy Carter. May 1977 The movie Star Wars opens up and becomes the highest-grossing film at that time. **April 1978** The United States votes to return the Panama Canal to Panama by December 31, 1999.

June 1973

- September 1978 The Camp David Peace Agreement is formulated and signed by Egypt and Israel. The negotiations are led by President Carter.
- October 1978 Pope John Paul II is elected Pope at Vatican City.
- March 1979 The largest accident in American nuclear history occurred at Three
 Mile Island nuclear plant in Middletown, Pennsylvania.
- November 1979 The Iran hostage crisis begins when 90 hostages, including 63
 Americans, are taken at the American Embassy in Tehran.
