2000:

- Mad Cow disease in alarms Europe

2001:

- Oklahoma City bomber Timothy McVeigh is executed
- September 11th the attack on the U.S. by terrorist groups led by Bin Ladin.
- U.N. tribunal in the Hague begins trial of Yugoslavian President Milosevic for war crimes.

2002:

- Hugo Chavez from Venezuela ousted in coup, reinstated two days later.

2004:

 NATO admits seven new countries, all from the old soviet bloc.

- Yasser Arafat dies in Paris
- Hamid Karzai is inaugurated as Afghanistan's first elected president.
- Al Qaeda bombs railroad system in Madrid, Spain killing over 200 people

2005:

- London is hit by terrorist bombing attack, killing 52 and wounding over 700.
- Pope John Paul II dies and Benedict XVI becomes next pope.
- Tony Blair becomes the first Labour Party Prime
 Minister to win three successive terns in the U.K.
- The Irish Republican Army announces is ending the violent campaign for a united Ireland.
- Angela Merkel becomes the first female chancellor of Germany.

2006:

- North Korea fires missile over the Sea of Japan (East Sea) and explodes nuclear device in mountains of North Korea.
- Saddam Hussein is convicted of crimes against humanity and is hung.
- Bombs go off on commuter trains in Mumbai, India.

2007:

- Nancy Pelosi becomes the first female speaker of the house of representatives.
- Investigation accuses 89 former and current baseball players of using illegal performance enhancing drugs.
- Pakistan has three changes of government in a twomonth period of time.

2008:

- Kosovo declares its independence from Serbia.
- Fidel Castro steps down as leader of Cuba after 49 years of being in power.
- Barak Obama becomes the U.S. President by beating John McCain in the election.
- The stock market suffers major losses at the end of President Bush's tenure.

2009:

- Australia has the worst wildfires in its history.
