C2 Attacks

C2 attacks are a serious threat that can infect public networks and do serious damage. Schools and municipalities need to know the causes and indicators of C2 attacks to craft an effective defense.

What is C2?

C2, or "Command and Control" attacks are caused by malware installed on your computer, which then communicates with a central server somewhere else. This is called the C2 server and can either steal your data or use your computer to commit other cyber-attacks.

Who are the perpetrators?

International criminal organizations are behind many C2 attacks.

How prevalent are C2 attacks?

Last year, there were 17,602 C2 servers being used for attacks.*

How bad are C2 attacks?

C2 servers can steal sensitive data and take over whole networks.

What can we do to protect our schools and municipalities?

General security precautions, such as changing passwords frequently and being wary of suspicious emails are good practices. Upgrading network security helps make it harder for criminals to do damage.
