# **FORMJACKING**

Formjacking is a sneaky new threat to public organizations. Public executives need to know the indicators to craft an effective defense.

# What is formjacking?

Formjacking is when cybercriminals inject malicious code into a website and take over the functionality of the site's form page. Hackers use this to collect sensitive user information such as credit card information.

## Who are the perpetrators?

Generally, international organizations are behind formjacking attacks.

### How prevalent is formjacking?

Symantec reported an average of 4,800 websites each month that had been compromised using malicious formjacking code.

### How bad is it?

Formjacking can go undetected for a while, as hackers use this technique to effectively steal personal information from multiple users.

What can we do to protect our schools and municipalities?
Unlike other cyberattacks, formjacking has few telltale signs. However, having a good cyber security system in place greatly reduces the risk.
