Effective: October 25, 2025

ADDITIONAL RULES:

PHOTOS:

- NO screenshots allowed.
- Accurate time stamps required and photo should correspond to the time of day.
- PHOTOs must be in one Album on one (1) phone for the Weigh-in.

NOTE: If the Team's fish is not in one album, you will drop behind the next person in line until you have put your fish photos you are submitting into one (1) album, on one (1) phone.

Remember, this will affect your weigh-in time, as this is a timed tournament when it comes to a tie.

- 2 Recorded Times:
 - 1. Ruler check-in time: when you check in your ruler at the weigh-in line.
 - 1 team member must stay in line at all times.
 - anyone late to the weigh-in is recorded (penalty is deducted for any arrival after 4:30)
 - 2. Weigh-in time: when you meet the Weigh Master.
 - Winning time will be based on the Weigh Master Time.
 - For any Team Late to weigh-in, their Time will be based on the Ruler check-in time.
 - Any discrepancies can be solved using both Ruler Check-in time and Weigh-in Time.
- Pictures will be reviewed/checked:
 - 1. while in the line prior to seeing the Weigh Master your photos will be checked for any discrepancies

LEAVING FROM ANOTHER PORT:

- share location for one (1) hour to Olivia at 239-850-0886 to verify your starting time/port location.
- REMEMBER: Safe first light is 7:03am for Oct 25, 2025.

WEIGH-IN LINE

- No more than 2 anglers from a team are to be in the line at any time.
- Only 2 anglers allowed at the weigh-in when discussing measurements with Weigh Master.
- If your whole Team is in the Line or joins the Team at the Weigh Master, you will be asked to choose up to 2 people only to discuss pictures.
