TAMILDA

Oooo you nasty grass! I may not be able to wear green but purple makes you look sick... and not in the good way hunny!

Kelly walks through the door into the shop, there is one lonely old man at the back eating but the rest of the shop is empty. She walks up to the counter but gets ignored.

MATILDA

How dare you! I may not look good in purple but at least I'm not allergic to glitter!

Kelly interrupts

KELLY

Excuse me

Matlida and Tamilda jump

TAMILDA

Oh! You scared us... why are you dressed like that?

Kelly looks at her average looking clothes and doesn't understand.

MATILDA

Now now Tamilda, that's no way to speak to a customer. I'm your server Matilda, nice to meet ya!

Matilda reaches out her hand as if to say 'kiss my ring'. Kelly pats her hand.

KELLY

You're called Matilda and Tamilda?

TAMILDA

Yes. It was a complete coincidence. What do you want?

MATILDA

Now now Tamilda. Its what can I get you? Not, what do you want?

Tamilda and Matilda acknowledge the camera crew and change tact.

TAMILDA

Oh! We heard you were coming.

They both run out of shot and come back in with even bigger wigs. The lights change and a glittery backdrops falls down. Matilda and Tamilda have microphones and are hamming it up for the camera. The old man at the back remains unphased.

MATILDA

Good Evening ladies and gentlemen, tonight's performance from Matlida and Tamilda is about to begin. Hold onto your hats because the show is about to go off...

KELLY

Sorry, could I quickly order? I don't think I can stay long!

The lights go back to normal and the glittery back drops falls down.

TAMILDA

Fine!

Tamilda clocks the camera again and starts to dramatically show off the different flavours in the glass counter top.

KELLY

Thank you - what are the choices?

MATILDA

Right infront of you darling...

The names of the frozen yoghurt are revealed to be normal looking gelatos with disgusting names. Snotty Snot, Mudbath, Dusty Box, Earwaxy, Old Bubblegum, Athleta Foota. Kelly looks disgusted.

KELLY

Oh wow! Are they like pretend names?

TAMILDA

No hunny, it is what you see.

KELLY

Don't you have anything like... chocolate?

MATILDA

Whats that dear?

KELLY

Just like... chocolate flavour?

TAMILDA

What is she talking about?

MATILDA

I do. Not. Know.

KELLY

You don't know what chocolate is?

Matlida and Tamilda are bewildered by the word Chocolate

MATILDA

Could you slow it down for us?

KELLY

Choc-o-late

MATILDA

No, didn't catch that. Once more?

KELLY

Ch-oc-o-la-te

MATILDA

Mmm no, maybe you're saying it wrong.

TAMILDA

Try and say it in a sentence hun.

KELLY

Ok... can I have a chocolate ice cream, please?

Matilda has a look of realistation

MATILDA

Oh!

TAMILDA

Do you know know what it is Matilda?

MATILDA

Nope, sorry I almost thought I had it then!

KELLY

Ok... got any Vanilla?

Matilda and Tamilda look bewildered again

KELLY (cont'd)

Strawberry?

They are both still confused

KELLY (cont'd)

Mint choc-chip? Cookies and Cream? Caramel? Pistachio?

MATILDA

Pistachio? Now, I think you're just making up words!

Kelly looks to the camera as if to question her sanity

KELLY

Ok, erm whats the most popular Frozen Yoghurt you sell?

TAMILDA

Hmmm... well out of the 7 customers we've ever had. Old Bubblegum has sold the most.

KELLY

Ok, fine. I will take it.

TAMILDA

Great!

Tamilda starts scooping away

KELLY

Got any toppings?

MATILDA

Ah yes, we have toe nail clipp...

KELLY

Actually. Don't worry.

MATILDA

Suit yourself sweetie.

Matilda rings up Kelly's order on the till.

MATILDA (cont'd)

That will be £27.58 then please

KELLY

Wow! That's an expensive fro-yo

MATILDA

Make-up is money honey. We need this to stay beautiful.

Kelly pulls out her voucher to pay.

MATILDA (cont'd)

Whats this?

KELLY

Oh it's a food voucher, Elizabeth gave it to me.

Matilda is shocked. Tamilda slides into shot with a giant bowl of blue frozen yoghurt

TAMILDA

Ew, she's paying with a voucher!

MATILDA

Bit rude if you ask me! After all our lovely service.

Kelly goes to apologise but Tamilda shakes her head, grabs some of the frozen yoghurt with her hand and throws it into a small paper pot and sticks a spoon in it. The whole thing is a mess. Kelly puts down the voucher and slowly takes the messy yoghurt. Matilda and Tamilda give her evils as Kelly slowly turns to leave the shop. Kelly looks at the mess in her hands and turns back around.

KELLY

Can I have a napkin?

Tamilda and Matilda gasp. They both dramatically point at the door. Slowly they begin to two step on the spot and click their fingers with their other hands, still pointing at the door. Kelly leaves sharply.
