It is very important that you read the information regarding Travel Protection closely, in the registration portal, to <u>understand your options and deadlines for purchasing the plan that include Cancel For Any Reason (CFAR) and for having Pre-Existing Conditions waived (must be purchased within 14 days of your initial payment). *CFAR is only offered with the Enhanced policy.* When registering, you will need to select to purchase travel protection and pay at that time; or, select that you do not want to purchase this product.</u>

September 2, 2025 - Day 1, Tuesday, Departure

Trans-Atlantic flight to Dublin

<u>September 3, 2025 - Day 2, Wednesday,</u> <u>Arrival Dublin</u>

Welcome in the Irish capital, Dublin! After a short orientation tour with your guide you will go to St. Mary's Pro Cathedral Roman Catholic church in the city center of Dublin, founded in 1825 to celebrate MASS. Lunch on your own proceed to your hotel for check in and time to refresh and to rest a little. DINNER and overnight in Dublin. Perhaps after dinner visit a local pub on your own this evening or return to the hotel and relax.

<u>September 4, 2025 - Day 3, Thursday,</u> Dublin,

After a full IRISH BREAKFAST enjoy a guided city tour of Dublin. Dublin has a historical perspective that stretches back to the bronze Age. During your guided tour, you will pass Trinity College, Merrion Square, Christ Church Cathedral and visit the Book of Kells, an illuminated manuscript of the four Gospels in Latin, produced c 800. End at St. Mary of the Angels, a friary church dating from 1881, to celebrate MASS. Lunch on your own and then visit the Guinness Storehouse at St. James Gate for a Brewery Tour and sample the brew. This evening you will attend an Irish DINNER show at the Arlington Hotel, or similar, where you will be entertained with Irish ballads and folk dance.

<u>September 5, 2025 - Day 4, Friday,</u> <u>Dublin - Mullingar- Knock- Galway</u>

After a full IRISH BREAKFAST check out and travel to the Kilbeggen Distillery established in 1757 and see how the process still is done today. Afterwards continue on towards Knock stopping en route for lunch on your own. Arrive at the National Shrine of our Lady of Knock where in 1879 fifteen people of the village witnessed an apparition of our Lady. Celebrate MASS and explore the shrine and the museum. Visit the beautiful gift shop before leaving. Continue to Galway and your hotel for DINNER and overnight.

September 6, 2025 - Day 5, Saturday, Galway

After a full IRISH BREAKFAST enjoy a scenic guided sightseeing tour of Galway. See Lynch's Castle, Eyre Square and the Spanish Arch. Celebrate MASS at Galway Cathedral that is also called St. Nicholas church and Our Lady Assumed into Heaven. Afterwards some free time for lunch on your own and some shopping. Dinner on your own, time to try some of the pubs, and overnight in Galway.

<u>September 7, 2025 - Day 6, Sunday,</u> <u>Galway, Cliffs of Moher - Killarney,</u>

Early full IRISH BREAKFAST check out and take your coach to St. Mary's Church, Claddagh a few minutes from the city center to celebrate MASS. Afterwards depart to see the country's most stunning natural sights; the Cliffs of Moher. These great dark sandstone cliffs rising from the Atlantic are 600 feet high and 5 miles long. You will be able to observe this spectacle from 0'Brien's Tower. Lunch on your own and then continue to Killarney for DINNER and overnight.

<u>September 8, 2025 - Day 7, Monday,</u> <u>Ring of Kerry - Killarney</u>

Full IRISH BREAKFAST and then drive to the "Franciscan Friary" for early MASS. Afterwards start a breath-taking drive around the "Ring of Kerry". Scenery includes plunging cliffs and lush lakeland, granite mountains and sandy beaches on County Kerry's largest peninsula. Wild and mountainous, County Kerry has long attracted tourists in search of magnificent scenery. Known as "the Kingdom" because its independence and disregard for Dublin rule, Kerry's dramatic landscapes and wealth of prehistoric and early Christian sites make it an unmissable destination. Perhaps see the sheep demonstration of how the dogs bring in the sheep at one of the stops on the Ring trip. Dinner on your own with many pubs for choices, and overnight in Killarney.

<u>September 9, 2025 - Day 8, Tuesday, Killarney</u>

Full IRISH BREAKFAST and celebrate MASS this morning at St. Mary's Cathedral and then a free day to enjoy Killarney and for personal sightseeing and shopping. Dinner on your own and overnight.

<u>September 10, 2025 - Day 9, Wednesday, Killarney - Blarney</u>

In the morning a full IRISH BREAKFAST and check out and depart for Blarney to the church of the Immaculate Conception to celebrate MASS. Afterwards drive to visit the Castle and experience kissing the Blarney stone. Enjoy a lunch (on your own) at the Stable Yards Café. Continue to your hotel in Dublin to check in. DINNER will be a dinner cruise along the beautiful Grand Canal.

<u>September 11, 2025 - Day 10, Thursday,</u> Dublin -

BREAKFAST and check out as you travel to Dublin airport for your flight to the USA.
