Dear Friends and Supporters,

Greetings everyone! We are excited to present to you our 2025 annual report and wanted to share a few highlights from the past year:

- During FY25, we provided safe shelter to 95 victims and transitional housing to 33 women and children for a total of 10,929 bednights! We answered 272 crisis calls and assisted 162 individuals with walk-in advocacy services.
- We provided 79 *Healthy Relationships Violence Prevention* presentations to 1578 students, grades K-12, in our central peninsula public schools. Topics included age-appropriate education on healthy relationships, conflict resolution, harassment prevention, domestic and dating violence, bullying prevention, etc. A big thank you to ConocoPhillips for their grant contribution each year to help us provide this program!
- Thanks to grant funding through the Rasmuson Foundation, we were able to address numerous maintenance and repair issues in both our emergency shelter and transitional housing facilities, including replacing carpet and tile, repairing sheetrock, and painting bedrooms, kitchens and living rooms.
- We had a great turn out for our 36th annual Violence Free Community Run with 75 runners competing in the event! We had great prizes for runners and lots of door prizes for everyone to enjoy thanks to all our wonderful sponsors and donors! A total of 155 individuals (staff, community members, volunteers) joined us for a fun filled day!
- We continue to provide numerous prevention awareness and education presentations throughout our community. Whether it's a community Wednesday Market open to the public or a formal event, LeeShore staff provided excellent information on how individuals can be more involved in helping make our community a safer and healthier place to live.
- We welcomed one new board member to our team earlier this year! All our board members are actively involved in The LeeShore Center's mission through fundraising, review of major financial decisions, approval of policy changes as necessary, and monthly board meetings. We continue to actively recruit for new members.

We could not do this work without you, our friends and supporters, and we offer you our sincerest thanks and deepest gratitude! And a special thank you to LeeShore staff and volunteers for your commitment to our mission and dedication to helping individuals in need!

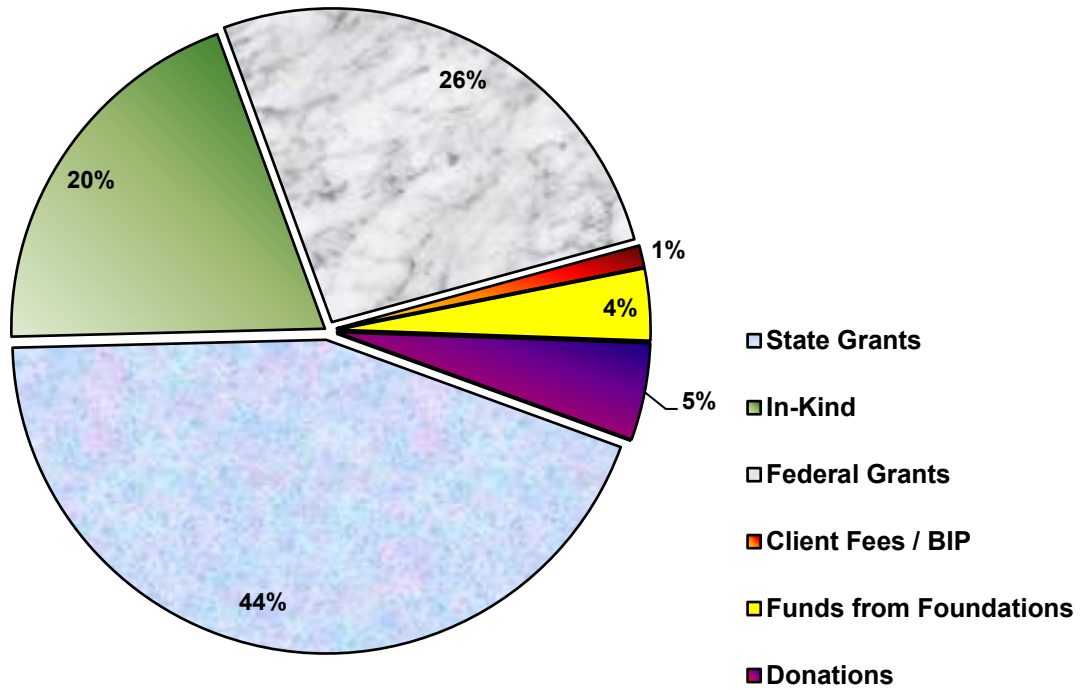

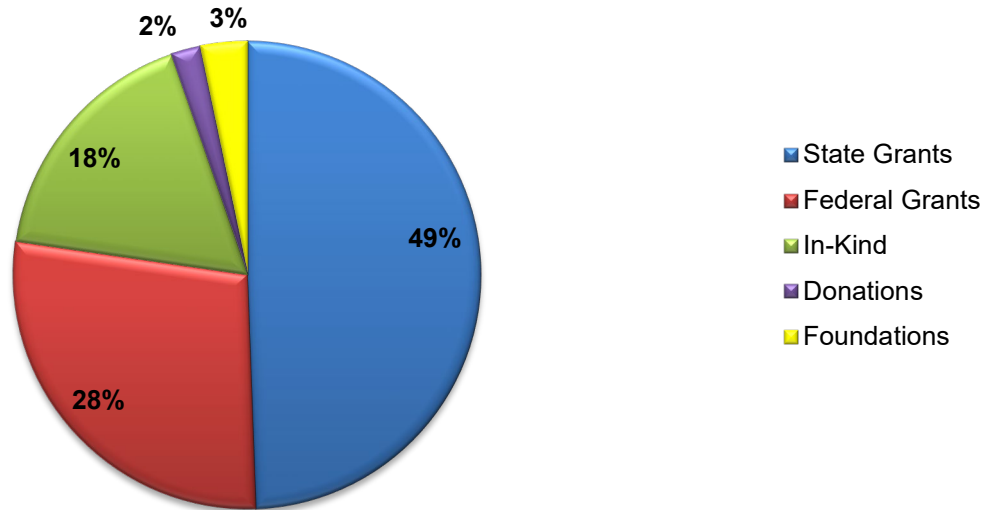

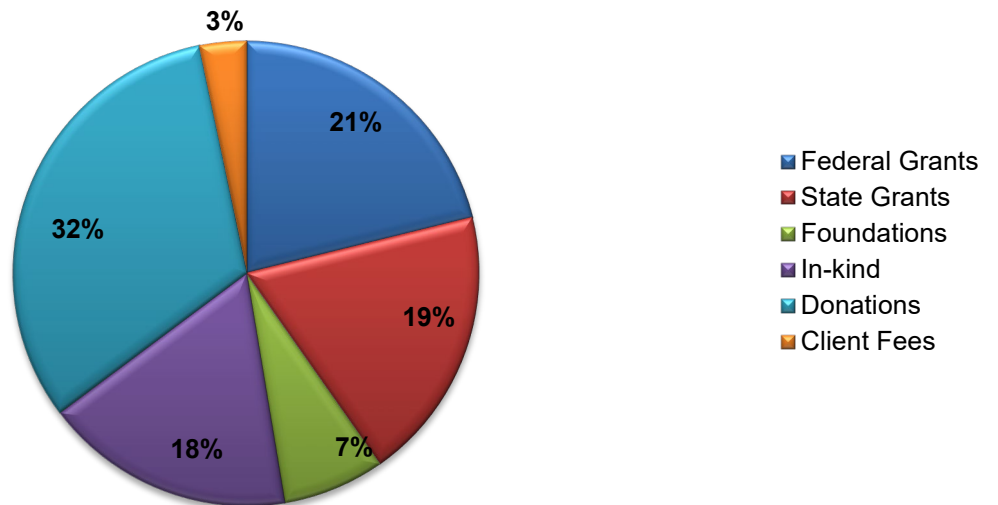
