Article title Notice that the very word is capitalized. The article title is the next word after the colon.
The journal name is in regular and capital each word. Volume number is in italics.
Journal of Asian Business Strategy, 33, 174-182.

The issue number is in brackets and there is no dot between the volume and issue number.
This reference has no doi number (doi = Digital Object Identifier) because there are no doi numbers for journal articles. Instead, the doi number is placed in the doi field of the reference entry.

Author Rules:
1. Initials are separated and ended by a period, e.g. Smith, J. A.
2. Multiple authors are separated by commas and an ampersand, e.g. Michael, J.A., Thomas, J., & Co.
3. Multiple authors with the same surname and initial add their name in square brackets eg. (Mendes, J. [James])

Date Rules:
1. Date refers to date of publishing
2. If the date is unknown, n.d. is used in its place eg. Mendes, J. (n.d.)

Title Rules:
1. The format of this changes depending on what is being referenced

Publisher Rules:
1. If in the US: the city and two letter state code must be stated e.g. New York, NY
2. If not in the US: the city and country must be stated e.g. Sydney, Australia

You include them every time you quote or paraphrase someone else's ideas or words to avoid plagiarism. An APA in-text citation consists of the author's last name and the year of publication (also known as the author-date system). If you're citing a specific part of a source, you should also include a locator such as a page number or timestamp. For example: (Smith, 2020, p. 170). Parenthetical vs. narrative citation The in-text citation can take two forms: parenthetical and narrative. Multiple authors and corporate authors The in-text citation changes slightly when a source has multiple authors or an organization as an author.
