

# A Veteran's Objective Go Bag

What you need depends on your trip, a trip to the store won't necessitate a huge bag that a weekend to the mountains would so pack up accordingly for the occasion.

- Poop bags - the amount depends on the trip
- Sanitizing wipes - bleach wipes (travel size)
- Baby wipes - any kind will do (travel size)

- Carabiner - you never know, they come in handy
- Small First aid kit - not always necessary until it's necessary
