\$65 for individual or trial lessons

To sign up for lessons, send us an email to NFFStables@gmail.com and we can provide a list of open spots on our schedule and get you started!

We prefer to assign the same day and time each week for all students but can occasionally swap days if needed to accommodate your schedule.

Lesson Information:

- All riders must wear a approved ASTM-SEI or equivalent helmet (a.k.a. hard hat) whenever mounted. We have plenty of hard hats in a variety of sizes, so don't go out and buy anything until you're sure riding is for you
- Riders must wear long pants, and closed toe shoes (preferably boots with a short flat heel, but hiking, snow or high-heeled boots won't work). Tennis shoes are acceptable for beginner riders
- Students need to arrive at least 20-30 minutes before the lesson to groom and tack, and allow at least 15 minutes after the lesson for cooling down, grooming and tack cleaning.
- We have a very flexible cancellation policy, but you need to let us know if you're not able to attend (call, email, text - even if it's right before your lesson). **If you don't acknowledge your cancellation, you will be charged for the lesson. If you cancel three lessons in a row, we cannot guarantee to hold your time slot.**
- Please park either in front of the barns or in the parking lot behind the barns - but be careful when driving through the barns! When approaching the indoor arena, call out "door" before entering so riders (and horses) know there is activity at the door. Please do not stand in the doorway of the arena (we have plenty of seats). Only riders and instructors may be in the arenas.
- Since we have a huge indoor arena, we can have lessons regardless of the weather!

This Liability Release binds not only the Releaser with regard to any claims arising from participation in these activities, but also the Releaser's spouse, heirs, legal guardian, legal representatives and assigns.

In consideration of the above stated purposes and the Releaser's permission to be on the premises of NFF Stables II, LLC, the Releaser forever releases, discharges and covenants to hold NFF Stables II, LLC, their employees, successors, assigns and legal representatives harmless from any and all claims, demands, costs, expenses, loss of services, acts and causes of action which may arise from any act or occurrence on account of any personal injury, disability, property damage, loss or damages of any kind sustained or that may hereafter be sustained by the Releaser in consequence of any act that may be occasioned on account of Releaser being on the premises of NFF Stables II, LLC, or that Releaser may sustain because of Releaser's proximity to horses and equine-related activities.
