Three-Day Camp: June 16-20 (optional half days 6/16 & 17)

We'll pack as much fun as we can into three days! Optional half days are from 1-4 pm, with free before camp activities beginning at 9 am for anyone who is out of school those days. Must attend both days.

About our riding camps...

NFF Stables' Day Camps are tons of fun! Each camper is assigned their "own" horse for the session, which they will learn to take care of and ride. In addition to getting to ride over four hours each day, campers get to participate in crafts (horse-related, of course!), trail rides, games on horseback, and learn all about horses.

- Designed for children aged 7 and up (special permission required for younger children)
- Campers can be beginners through advanced for the 3 and 5-day camp; but must be enrolled in lessons (either at NFF or another riding program) for Five-and-a-half day camp
- Limited enrollment for a high staff-to-camper ratio
- Our facilities include a huge lighted indoor riding arena, large outdoor riding areas, and tons of trails on the farm. Camp will be held regardless of weather
- Camps run from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Before and After camp supervision available at no additional cost



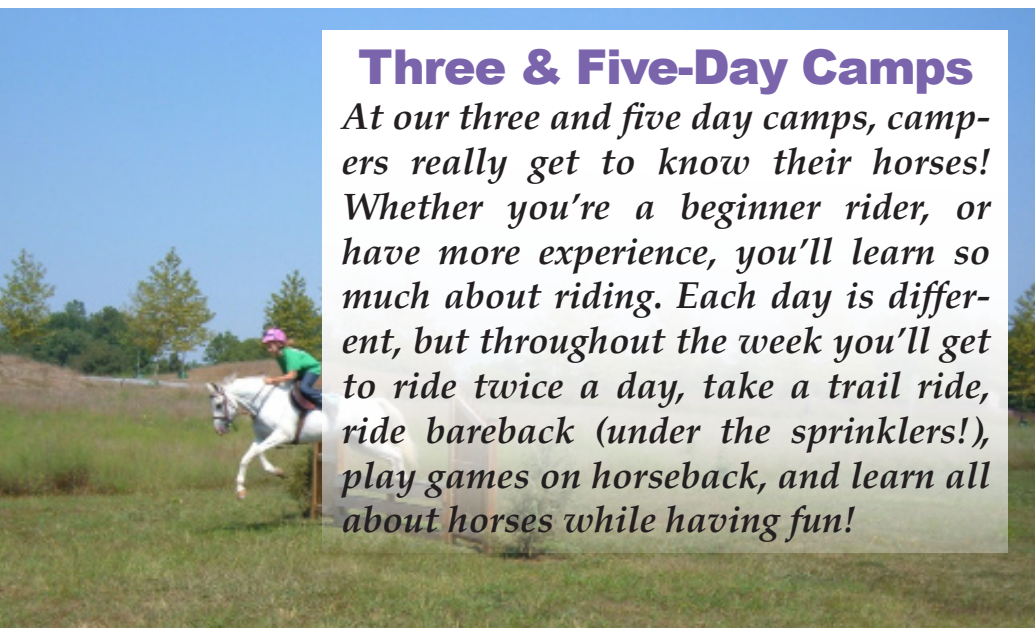
Five-and-a-half Day Camp
