Internship Description

Overview

This position is built to expand and enhance the team and league's social media presence both locally and nationally. From highlighting players and fans to promoting events and designing programs to engage fans, this position is critical in the ongoing growth of the Pioneers and the Front Range League.

This position, based in Gering, Nebraska, will work closely with the marketing/promotional team to ensure brand continuity and positive fan experience from game to game. Using all available social media platforms and integrating those platforms into a cohesive program is key to this position. This position will give you an immediate step towards a career in sports and entertainment management, and reports to the General Manager. Please be prepared to start on or about May 20, 2025 (school schedule will be taken into consideration).

Qualifications

The following are prerequisites for the position:

- A love of event promotion through social media – your creativity passion will help this position succeed. Social media is our major outlet of promotion - our success is directly tied to your success in this department
- Well-organized – we are a lean and efficient organization and need to stay organized to be successful
- Goal-oriented – like the players, the front office will set goals and use them to measure our success
- Ability to multi-task and work independently – we all chip in, and we need people that can do the right thing without waiting to be told to do it!
- Candidate must be prepared to work game nights and other stadium events during the season

HOURLY REQUIREMENTS AND COMPENSATION

Intern is responsible for transportation to and from Gering, Nebraska. Start date is approximately May 20, 2025 and end date is approximately August 5, 2025.
