

Ogen en oren

What does the ILT do? (The Competent Authority of The Netherlands)


The ILT ensures fair supervision, good service and licensing and adequate detection. The ILT also conducts research.

Eyes and ears

The ILT also functions as the eyes and ears of the minister and the state secretary. It informs government officials about risks and new developments. The inspectors are often the first to see if the policy works and what developments and risks are.



TANK-CONTAINER / PORTABLE TANK



ONE YEAR LATER (IN COMPARISON WITH 2016)

The Inspectorate compared both 140 inspections

- Inspections without infringements/deviations:
 2016: 43% → 2017: 54,3% (improvement of >11%)
- Total found infringements / deviations:
 2016: 146 → 2017: 80 (severe reduction)







DUAL APPROVAL ADR 6.7 & 6.8

- A tank which is dual approved and contains both markings must ensure that the marking at all time corresponds with the actual equipment presented. The tank must fulfill the most stringent construction and equipment conditions
- ADR 6.7 uses T instruction : example T-11 or T-12
- ADR 6.8 uses T code :example L4BN or L4BH
- For the use the transport route is leading



Authorized / approved bodies


- Adjustments of certificates: 19x
- No marking of the tankcode and/or portable tank instruction: 12x
- False / wrong metal marking plate: 2x
- Hermetically closed tank (external pressure 0,21 bar) without vacuum valve: 3x







TANK-CONTAINER/PORTABLE TANK OPERATOR



OTHER INFRINGEMENTS ALSO RELATED TO FILLER, CARRIER OR CONSIGNOR

- Filling rates: 18x (3 partcipants concerned)
- Broken frangible / bursting discs / pressure gauge: 2x
- (Rest) Product outside: 3x
- Closure drip cap (3^e closure): 25x
- No gauze flame traps: 3x
- Broken clamp: 1x
- Unsuitable /outdated Gasket (replaced): 7x
- Missing remote control: 3x
- Documents / labelling/ psn 5x
- Tank-container (6.8 ADR) was not approved as IMO 4: 1x
- Pressure setting valve too high: 1x





COMPANY RELATED INSPECTIONS

Several inspection points:

- Comparison of the initial reports and the (2,5 and 5 year) approvals
- Are the initial reports/certificates in accordance with the legislation?
- Are the devices, equipment, tankinstructions, tankcodes still the same as during the approval?
- How is the anchoring in the system in relation to repairs/surveys?
- Reality checks



Conclusion:

4 of the 5 companies: Enforcement under administrative law



BUT . . .



Tankoperator:


Still more than 50% of the infringements are related to this participant:

- no or wrong portable tankinstruction on the tank or metal plate (6.7) (20x)
- no -, wrong or false marking of the tankcode (6.8) (13x)
- Tanks equiped in a higher tank hierarchy without authorisation (4x)
- Hermetically closed tank (external pressure -0,21 bar) without vacuum valve (2x)
- Missing flame trap (3x)
- Missing remote control (1x)





CONCLUSIONS:





POSSIBLE PROPOSALS



- Most infringements are related to dual certification: It is preferable that tanks can only be single approved
- Develope and prescribe one document / layout of approval (as 9.1.3.5 ADR for road tankers)
- Reformulate the definition of "tankoperator". Add the "holder" as participant (for example in relation to long lease (> 3 month))
- Regular technical meetings between the experts of different authorized/approved bodies



In the majority of inspections, USDOT Audits result in fines for lack of:

- General awareness training
- Function specific training
- Maintenance of training records




