MilKFill 3 Plus Fine is formulated for thin and sensitive parts of the face such as under eye area (tear troughs), marionette lines, crow's feet, small volume on lips. MilKFill 3 Plus Fine is enriched with lidocaine for improved comfort during injection, it features high viscoelasticity and a smooth gel texture, allowing precise shaping with long-lasting effects. The inclusion of lidocaine further enhances the patient's treatment experience.

How to use MilKFill 3 Plus Fine General Instructions for Filler Injection Procedure MilKFill 3 Plus must be administered by certified medical professionals. Proper disinfection of the injection site is required. Bruising and swelling may occur post-procedure and usually subside within 7 days. The procedure typically takes 15–30 minutes. Recommended needle type with MilKFill 3 Plus Fine is 30G-31G. Common Filler Injection Techniques 1 Tunneling Technique Used for linear wrinkles and volume lines, filler is injected retrogradely while withdrawing the needle at a 30–45° angle. 2 Point Technique Involves injecting micro-droplets into the dermis or subcutaneous layer for overall skin lifting and hydration. 3 Stretching Technique Stretching the skin provides more visibility and accuracy when injecting into areas with sagging or loose tissue. 4 Dual Plane Technique Applies filler to both the dermis and subdermal layers to treat wrinkles and volume loss simultaneously, sometimes using different densities of filler for each layer.
