STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM

The purpose of the “STEWARDSHIP” program is to create a sense of responsibility and build pride in our organization. To hold our teammates to a higher standard of conduct. To this end we will assign a “STEWARD” for each group. The steward will be responsible to assure their group follows the rules of golf course usage which are as follows:

Do not leave any tees on the tee box after teeing off

Ninety degrees means to enter the course from the cart path to your ball in an exact ninety degree manner.

Do not drive down the fairway to your next shot but exit the fairway again in the same ninety degree pattern

Never drive in/on areas designated as Ground Under Repair

Do not drive over or through roped off areas.

Fill your divot and 2 others.

Always exit at or before “no cart “sign or posting

Never drive on or near the collar of the green

When parking the golf cart by the green, all 4 wheels must be on the cart path

On the green fix your ball mark and 2 others

There is absolutely no driving on any par 3 hole

“Cart Path Only” or holes with the same designation, do not drive on the rough nor the fairway.

Pick up all trash and deposit in the appropriate receptacle
