The Gallery has flourished and continues to delight customers with the original production and design artwork for many favourite albums and singles that they already own, or remember owning.

Our mission was to preserve these important artworks, many of which had been thrown out and discarded by the record companies that commissioned them. Some of them never made it past the drawing board or were sent back to the art studios for corrections.

It is our belief that they are an important part of our cultural history and a link in the Pop Art chain that has long been forgotten.

Our goal is to bring these to a final permanent home in the UK.

The gallery is further embellished by original works of art to complement the cover art and Limited edition prints, vinyl and original poster ads and memorabilia associated with the covers.

Working alongside famebureau.co.uk website and their collection, we offer for sale some of the rarest artworks and Music-based Art Products and associated Memorabila.

We are believed to be the only company specialising in this area of Art and as such have access to collections, not available anywhere else in the world.



POP NOUVEAU AT STRAWBERRY FIELD

LENNON WIRED

In 2020 Artist James Wilkinson created 11 pieces of art using the original microphone leads that John Lennon Used to record his seminal album and single 'Imagine'. Destined to be exhibited on the 50th anniversary year, Pop Nouveau Gallery was offered exhibition space for the Lennon Wired Exhibition in varius destinations around the world.

One of those spaces was Lennon's childhood sanctuary, Strawberry Field in Liverpool, the inspiration for the Beatles double A side. Single Strawberry Fields/Penny Lane.

In April 2021 the exhibition was launched by John Lennon's sister Julia Baird and attended by various Beatles aficionados including the original surviving members of the Quarrymen.

The exhibition joined the Imagine Piano which has been loaned to Strawberry Field by George Michael's Estate and was expected to stay at Strawberry field for 6 months but due to the popularity and success of the exhibition, the installation was extended by another year until the end of September 2023.

The gallery is now talking to destinations worldwide to take the exhibition on a tour of peace around the world.


















POP NOUVEAU AT STRAWBERRY FIELD STRAWBERRY FIELD BANDSTAND

In 2018 Cliff Cooper, CEO of Orange Amplifiers, contacted James Wilkinson with an idea to create a bandstand for Strawberry Field as a donation to the Salvation Army who had helped his father after the first World War . The bandstand would be the most hi-tech bandstand ever built and James was commissioned to produce the artwork for the roof, the back of the stage and the outside.

The bandstand was brilliantly designed by Mick Dines and was based on the Sgt Pepper drum. James made his preliminary sketches and designs in 2018 which were initially approved. In 2021 the bandstand build was approved by all parties and the artwork began in earnest. Many proofs were created and rejected until the final images were unanimously approved and the installation began in May 2022 in time for a soft opening and then a formal hand-over on September 2023.

The back of stage mural is an impressive 8.5Mx3M withe the roof design 8M in diameter and the 4 outside images each 1m diameter.

Proof artwork is still available for this project exclusively at Pop Nouveau Gallery.






PRODUCTION ARTWORK IS WHERE IT STARTS.

Using selected photographs, typefaces and original drawings, the designers and paste-up artists turn the concept for the cover into reality. Pasted onto artboard. The artwork is then photographed to create the first generation proofs to be approved by the Band, the management and or the record company.

Production artwork is the rarest of all media and in the modern digital world these artworks no longer exist. it is the origin of all subsequent proofs and ultimately the finished product. The design would likely be altered before production making these versions rare and unreleased





PROOF ARTWORK

Some proofs never made it past the 'drawing board' and as such differ from the released version and are extremely collectable. In the digital age they no are no longer produced and therefore are becoming increasingly sought after.

JOHN LENNON WALLS & BRIDGES

The Original Design Artwork

The proof artwork designs were discarded in the 1970s and sold in the car park of `Capitol Records at one of the regular SwapMeets. It remained with the buyer for approximately 45 years before being publicly auctioned. It is virtually impossible to collect any Beatle's album artwork so these items are beyond rare. They remain a piece of Lennon and Beatles history, not least because the album spawned Lennon's only solo number one single, 'Whatever gets you thru the night', his only collaboration with Elton John and because of this led to his appearance at Elton's gig after Elton bet him that it WOULD get to number one. It was recorded during Lennon's only solo time apart from Yoko Ono and it also sees Harry Nilsson's appearance on the album, the only time they collaborated with each other. This album artwork is part of the lost era of POP ART and one of the finest examples, not just as an album cover but as the whole collection of the production artwork.

A hugely rare and important piece of Artwork for one of the Beatles

The artwork produced by Shoot That Tiger Art Studio in 1984 are the original artworks for both back and front covers, and inner sleeves These two initial presentations were yet subject to change. The handwritten Typeface notes on the mount for the lettering on the front cover and the back sleeve notes and credits yet to be added. Two of the temporary space fliers on the back have pieces torn from them, although the images for the back cover have already been decided and placed.

The outer cover artworks have a single acetate overlay and paper mount and are on their original CS10 art boards.

Totally Unique they are the only ones in existence and come with a hand signed letter of authentication from the owner of Shoot That Tiger commissioned to produce all of the artwork for this album in all formats

ROLLING STONES ORIGINAL PRODUCTION ARTWORK

This artwork with a single acetate overlay differs from the released album because the Title is SLOW ROLLER and not the finalised SLOW ROLLERS.

The single acetate overlay has the Title hand painted in gold ink and the missing 'S' was likely added on another artwork at a later stage, making this artwork unbelievably rare as no other will be in existence.

The last release on the DECCA label for the stones, this Artwork came over from their archives to Shoot That Tiger Art Studios who were working on potential re-releases.





The original Alternate Artwork for Jimi Hendrix Electric Ladyland album cover Extremely rare and beautiful piece of production artwork was rejected by Reprise records in favour of the gatefold album artwork for Electric Ladyland. It is a very pop, almost Warhol presentation, making it extremely appealing. On its original art-board, with all original paste-ups and handwritten notes. The art cover included, on verso of the art-board denotes that Reprise removed the artwork from its production cycle in 1968, never once having used it. The finished album cover caused huge controversy not least with Hendrix himself who had submitted his own designs to the record company only to find that they were ignored in favour of the now legendary 'nudes' inner sleeve only in death was Hendrix' vision completed when the album was re-released with Linda McCartney's photograph of there band in Central Park by the Alice in Wonderland statue. With a separate original framed artwork for the Electric Ladyland logo created at the same time.

He is also known for being one of the artists associated with Iron Maiden's mascot Eddie. He designed the album covers for Iron Maiden's Fear of the Dark, Virtual XI, Death on the Road, and The Final Frontier, as well as the covers for the single, making him the only artist other than Derek Riggs to have been used to draw Eddie on more than one Iron Maiden album. 





THE ORIGINAL MASTER ARTWORK ADVERTISEMENTS

Again these are the only ones in existence. Artworks for adverts are actually more rare than their album and single cover counterparts. Album covers were expected to be around for many decades after release, whereas the adverts generally appeared for one day only and gave the artists that designed them a little more licence to be creative. Most of the advertisement artworks were destroyed as there was no need for them after publication. These are increasingly sought after, as one-offs.


