Heat Relief

March-September

I-HELP

(Year-round)

Interfaith Homeless Emergency Lodging Program (I-HELP) is a program where faith organizations open their facilities one night a week/month to provide a safe place to sleep for people experiencing homelessness. Local non-profit, AZCEND oversees the I-HELP program.

Needs:

- Volunteers to cook dinner for a group of 25
- Volunteers to drive a 25 passenger bus in the morning and evening
- Volunteers to help wash blankets and towels



Willis Jr High

(Year-round)

Junior high students are sometimes forgotten, so we've partnered with a local Title I school to offer community support to students in need and their families.

Needs:

- Donations of clothing, shoes, and toiletries for students
- Donations of printer paper, tissues, and other classroom supplies for teachers

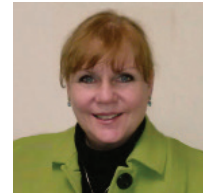
