Your Contributions At Work

Dollar-For-Dollar Arizona State Tax Credit

The State of Arizona Qualifying Charitable Organizations (QCO's) Tax Credit for Donations is a dollar-for-dollar Arizona tax credit for charitable contributions to qualifying 501(c)(3) non-profits. With your contribution, you will receive a state tax credit up to \$495 if filing single and \$987 if filing a joint state tax return.



HOW DO I QUALIFY?

For Our City - Chandler (FOC-C) is an Arizona Qualifying Charitable Organization (QCO). When filing your 2025 Arizona State Taxes, you must include FOC-C's QCO Reference Code: **22527**

TAX CREDIT VS TAX DEDUCTION

A qualifying tax credit is significantly more beneficial than a tax deduction. Deductions can reduce the amount of your income before you calculate the tax you owe. However, tax credits can reduce the amount of tax you owe or increase your tax refund.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

 Can I take the credit for donations made to QCO's if I take the School Tax Credit and Arizona Foster Care Tax Credit?

Yes, they are separate and you are allowed to take advantage of all three.

What happens if I don't owe State taxes at the end of the year?

The QCO tax credit reduces your overall state tax liability and is not impacted by your tax withholdings during the course of the year. If you withheld more than what you owed, the credit will result in an increase in your state tax refund. If you have no Arizona tax credit liability for the current year, you may carry the tax credit forward for up to five years.
