2019 Event Stats

- **Backpacks:** Over 2,120 backpacks were given to students from pre-school all the way to high school.
- **Uniforms:** 3,637 individual pieces of clothing were donated to Title 1 schools.
- **Shoes:** 1,070 pairs of shoes were distributed.
- **Socks and Underwear:** Over 4,274 socks and underwear were distributed.
- **Volunteers:** Over 229 individuals provided 856 total hours of volunteer service towards this event.
- **Schools:** Students from all 47 schools in Chandler Unified School District were reached through this event.
