#### 1. Game Time Limit

All games are subject to a strict three-hour time limit. No new inning may begin after the three-hour mark.

Start Time Definition: The game clock begins at the plate meeting or when the home team takes the field, whichever occurs first.

#### 2. Uniform Requirements

All players and coaches/managers must wear team-colored jerseys with unique identifying numbers. Baseball pants are required. Base coaches are encouraged to wear helmets.

## 3. Refund & Injury Policy

No refunds will be issued after a player participates in their first regular season game.

Players who suffer season-ending injuries are eligible for a prorated refund based on games missed, assuming a free agent is available to assume their league player fee. Should a free agent not be available, the injured player may be denied a refund.

The refund rate is \$15 per missed regular game, based on a standard per-game fee.

Refund eligibility begins only after official removal from the roster by the league commissioner.

Players must submit a refund request within 14 days of injury and may be required to provide medical documentation.

Refunds are processed within 30 days and will not be issued for fewer than 4 missed games unless league dues were paid in full at the time of injury.

## 4. Forfeiture Accountability

Teams that forfeit a game without giving at least 24 hours' notice must reimburse the league for umpire and field fees associated with that game. These fees may be added to the team's account.

# 5. Coach & Player Conduct

Coaches/managers are responsible for fair playing time distribution, especially among paying players. Repeated benching without valid cause may result in suspension.

Malicious conduct (e.g., intentionally injuring players, aggressive physical contact, throwing at players) will lead to disciplinary review and possible removal.

#### 6. Dugout Access Restrictions

Only registered players and coaches may be in the dugout or on the field during games. No bat boys, family members, or spectators are allowed in team areas. This is due to liability insurance and safety.

### 7. Bat Specifications

Players must use BBCOR certified -3 Metal bats or wood/composite bats. All bats must be professionally made and free of compromising imperfections. Players are encouraged to use Baum Bats.
