### BUTTERCRUNCH LETTUCE

Developed by George Raleigh, Cornell University, and an All America Selection for 1933. Classic butterhead type was the standard for many years. Very heat-tolerant, slow to bolt.

### PLANTING INSTRUCTIONS

Use 1/2 inch thick bands for baby greens or space 8 inches apart for head lettuce. Best grown as a spring or fall crop in most areas.


