

THINNING

Lettuces, Carrots, Beets, Radish or anything planted by small seed needs to be thinned.

Once the plants are about 3-4" tall, the best way is to create an invisible circle around each plant, pulling out or transplanting the extra. Leave a 2-3" spacing for each plant. This will give each plant root space to spread out. If you want the "supermarket" look, thinning is a must.
