#### Who regulates open burning in Florida?

The Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (DACS), Florida Forest Service (FFS) regulates the vast majority of open burning in Florida, most of which is associated with agricultural, silvicultural, land clearing, and prescribed fire operations. All open burning conducted under the authority of FFS requires an authorization from FFS prior to commencing any open burning activity. FFS will only authorize the burning of vegetative debris that was generated at the site of the open burn. FFS will not authorize the burning of vegetative debris that has been transported to an offsite burn area, except for storm-generated debris as provided in Section 403.7071, Florida Statutes (F.S.).

The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) is responsible for regulating air pollution related to open burning throughout the state. Regulations pertaining to open burning (outlined below) are primarily found in Chapters 62-256, 5I-2, and subsection 62-293.320(3) of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).

#### Residential Yard Waste

Open burning of "yard waste" (defined as leaves, shrub trimmings, grass clippings, palm fronds, and brush) on residential premises of not more than two family units is allowed, provided that the below requirements in subsection 62-256.700(1), F.A.C., are met.

- 1. The yard waste must have been generated on the same premise as where it's being open burned.
- 2. The open burning must occur between the hours of 8:00 AM CST (9:00 AM EST) to one hour before sunset.
- 3. The open burning must be enclosed in a noncombustible container or be in a pile no greater than eight feet in diameter.
- 4. The location of the open burn must be set back at least 150 feet from any occupied building other than that of the landowner, 50 feet from any paved public roadway, and 25 feet from any wildlands, brush, or combustible structure.
- 5. The open burning must be attended with fire extinguishing equipment ready at all times.
- 6. Authorization from FFS is <u>not</u> required for burning of residential yard waste; however, it is recommended that you still contact FFS regarding burn conditions for the day(s) you plan to open burn.

#### Reminder

Mailbox numbers are available in Home Depot, ACE and other stores. The paint for mailbox post is available in the HOA office, FREE for pick up. No Boat/RV in the front yard or Driveway.

#### **Violations of our Declarations and Fines**

As some of you have already noticed, the Compliance Office is now sending out notices of non-compliance that the Windover Farms Board of Directors can issue fines for. If you receive a letter for non-compliance, please get it taken care of within the time period specified, usually 14 days. The ultimate goal of compliance is to maintain Windover Farms as a first-class community and to abide by the Association's deed restrictions, which were acknowledged upon purchasing in Windover Farms.

The state of Florida has granted HOA's the power to fine and suspend rights as found in the Florida Statutes: Subsection 720.305 (2).

As such, the Board will begin to impose fines on violations specifically mentioned in our governing declarations. These fines will be in the amount of \$100 and can reach a maximum of \$1,000 if the violation is not remedied. Prior to a fine being levied, the homeowner will be given a period of time to correct the violation, but if not corrected, the fine will be imposed.

Should a homeowner wish to appeal the fine, a Fine Review Committee will review the alleged violation and make a final determination. Bear in mind that if a fine is levied, it has been directly associated with a listed violation in our declarations.

#### **Top 10 Fineable violations:**

- 1. Residential Use No building/construction without ARC approval
- 2. No Temporary Buildings, trailers, sheds
- 3. Commercial vehicle parked outside of garage
- 4. Unlicensed or inoperative motor vehicle parked on roadway or lot
- 5. No vehicle or any other type of equipment shall be used for living, sleeping
- 6. No artificial grass, plants or other artificial vegetation
- 7. No sign without ARC approval (4 sq ft maximum)
- 8. Maximum 2 animals per lot unless approved by Board
- 9. No boarding up of house, unless during storm likely to cause damage
- 10. No change in topography unless approved by ARC

#### **ARC** applications

If you plan to do **ANYTHING** to the exterior of your home or landscaping, check with the office to be sure that you are complying with the appropriate application. Even though you may have had your contractor do this for you, it should be understood that you, the homeowner, are ultimately responsible for compliance.

#### Windover Farms Needs You!

The Architectural Review Committee needs new members to help keep the community the beautiful home we all love. If you are interested in becoming an ARC member, please contact the office with your name, address/lot number and contact information and a current ARC member will reach out to you.

There is a meeting once a month on the third Tuesday of the month, and you will also be asked once or twice a month to do final inspections for homeowners who have finished their projects.


