
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# Hurricane Season is Here!

June is the official start of hurricane season, and now is the time for homeowners to ensure that their homes are storm-worthy. Everyday maintenance items, such as ensuring that gutters are free of debris, making those last-minute repairs to potential roof leaks, and re-evaluating your hurricane readiness plans are essential. While these may seem to be relatively small items, their importance should not be overlooked. Wind driven rain backing up under a roofline, or working its way into loose shingles or broken tiles can become a major problem, especially when coupled with a tropical storm or hurricane. Attempting last minute repairs with a storm heading your way can be very costly, not to mention difficult to complete under adverse weather conditions. Being prepared with a good on-going home maintenance plan, and a hurricane readiness plan can save you dollars, and precious time in an emergency. In the event of the storm, please consider the following:

- Please be sure that your culverts and swales are open and clear to allow flood waters to flow unimpeded. Otherwise, if there's a flood event, you could be seeing the high-waters first!
- DO NOT leave branches and clippings in front of your house before a storm. These can become windborne debris, and create a hazard not only for you, but your neighbors as well.
- Secure all loose items, and bring your patio furniture inside.

Reminder: Please do not board-up your house unless a hurricane emergency has been declared.

#### **Yard Waste Issues:**

There have been numerous complaints about yard debris piles that have been placed on County right-of-ways, or on common property. Be advised that Waste Management will not pick up the yard waste unless it is on a **valid property with an address** (no canal right of ways, empty lots, or what is considered County or common property). If you generate the debris, please pile it up on the curb at your address, not on an adjacent vacant lot or easement area.

Also, if the pile is larger than 3 yards (the size of 3 washing machines), please call Waste Management at **321-723-4455** to schedule a pickup with the claw truck. If you call on or before a Monday (Windover Farms' yard debris pick-up day), the debris will be retrieved within 3 business days. There is no charge for this service.

However, if you hire a company to trim or cut down trees and clean-up debris, Brevard County ordinance requires that any business that performing this service must remove the cuttings, etc.

**DO NOT Hire** door to door venders without first checking if they are licensed and insured.

Windover Farms of Melbourne By-law requests that YOUR CONTAINER MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE CURB THE EVENING OF THE PICKUP DAY AND STORED OUT OF SIGHT FROM THE ROAD.

We sincerely appreciate being informed, and we thank our residents who comply with the Rules and Regulations, and help us the keep our community beautiful!

#### ARC APPLICATION POLICY

The By-laws and Deed Restrictions for Windover Farms of Melbourne require an application be submitted not only for new construction, but also for changes or modifications to the EXTERIOR of existing homes and property.

#### Examples:

- 1. Add a detached garage or build a pool,
- 2. Repaint your home with the same color or different color,
- 3. Replace rotten wood columns at your front porch,
- 4. Replace roof with the same or different materials,
- 5. Redo your driveway,
- 6. Cut down a tree which is too close to your house
- 7. Clean up some area in your backyard to redo landscaping.
- 8. Build a play house

Specific applications for different types of projects are available on the website at <a href="https://www.windoverfarms.com">www.windoverfarms.com</a>. Requirements for submittals vary depending upon the nature of the project and are clearly stated in the individual application.

ARC (Architectural Review Committee) meetings are held monthly on the third (3<sup>rd</sup>) Tuesday of the month at 7:30 p.m.

Applicants are encouraged to attend the meeting to answer any questions that an ARC member may have as this would help to avoid any delays in the approval process.

#### **IMPORTANT!**

Projects or modifications that are begun prior to being submitted and approved by the ARC may be referred to the Windover Farms Attorney. At that point, any expenses incurred by the Association to resolve the matter will become the responsibility of the property owner. Failure to satisfy the billing for the legal fees associated with this action will result in a lien being placed against the property by the Association. (See www.windoverfarms.com/ARC-Forms)




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
