## **Basketball Court Closed Indefinitely**

Due to repeated noise complaints, and vandalism on the lawn in front of the Windover Farms pavilion, the Board has elected to remove the basketball hoop in an attempt to halt any further destruction of property.

Similar to previous occurrences, the latest incident (pictured below) was perpetrated by an individual leaving the court, late at night, who intentionally throttled his engine across the lawn in an apparent attempt to throw mud and grass in the direction of his playmates. As before, the incident was observed on video.

While the Board understands that the vast majority of people who play basketball are respectful of the neighborhood, there are some *guests* of residents who are not respectful or concerned about the quiet enjoyment of those who live in close proximity.

If you have any information about the person who caused the latest damage, please call the office at 321-259-2216. If we can ensure that our resident basketball players will make it clear to their guests that further disturbances and property damage will not be tolerated, the Board may reconsider its position.



## Guidelines for Swings

For a swing to be located in the front or side yard in Windover Farms, it must solely be used for landscape decoration, and under no circumstances be used for play. For a hanging "single" swing, acceptable material for the seat is wood (or wood-like) and it is to be supported by rope. Double-wide wooden swings are also allowed if they are supported by rope or a wooden A-frame.

Examples of swings that are *not* approved for use in the front or side yards would include plastic seats, rubber tires, and swings and hammocks made of cloth or netting, or swings supported by chains.

Any type of ornamental swing not covered by this policy would need to receive permission from the ARC on a per case basis.

## Hurricane Preparation

Peak hurricane season is here so it's important to begin yard preparations now. If there is a storm bearing down, it will be too late to discard dead palm fronds and tree limbs, which can become dangerous projectiles in high winds.

Please follow these rules when preparing these items for collection by Waste Management:


- If the fronds and branches are small, place them in cans for normal yard waste collection.
- Larger branches and fronds should be cut to four feet
- Lengths and stacked in a uniform direction. They should be placed within four feet of the curb. Do not to block gutters, streets or sidewalks. Plastic bags are not allowed.
- For large piles that require a special collection, Windover residents can call Waste Management at 321-723-4455 to arrange for the pickup Currently, regular yard waste collection is done on Mondays.

Once a storm threatens, collection of refuse and recycling will stop when winds make it unsafe for the trucks and landfill personnel.

While clearing your property of yard waste, make sure to check for loose objects, including buckets, chairs, shovels, and rakes. Store these items inside.

This is also a good time to check your garage for unneeded hazardous products. The Sarno landfill accepts this on Thursdays, Fridays, and Saturdays.
