Registration Steps:

Step 3: In Program Search Box enter "Summit Academy Charter School" (even though we are Harbor MS, we are collaborating with the other school in the building) then click magnifying

Step 4: Click "Add to List" when Summit Academy Profile shows on the pageglass to search

Step 5: If you already have an account then click sign in or set up a new account

Step 6: Complete the application pages to attach your child to the school

Step 7: SUBMIT the application and you will receive a confirmation email to verify a successful submission
