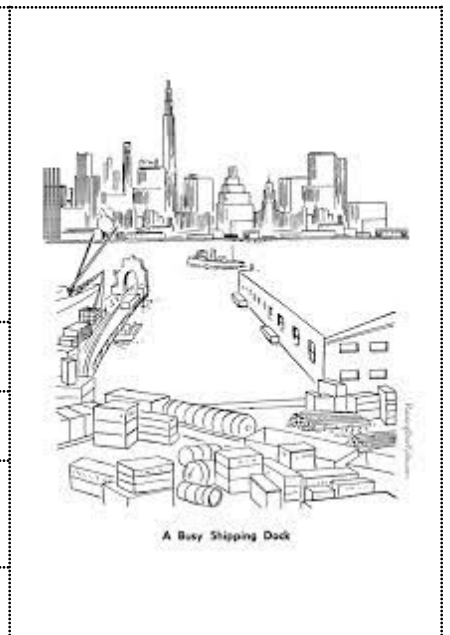
Guitar Club

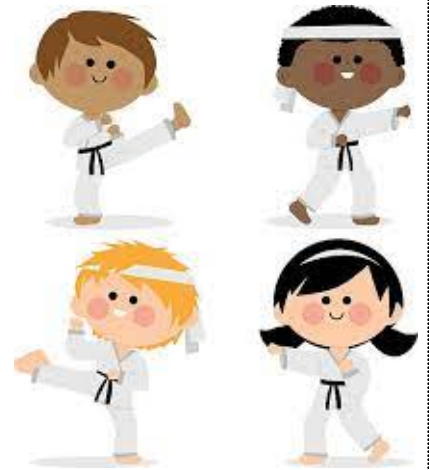
Harbor Club

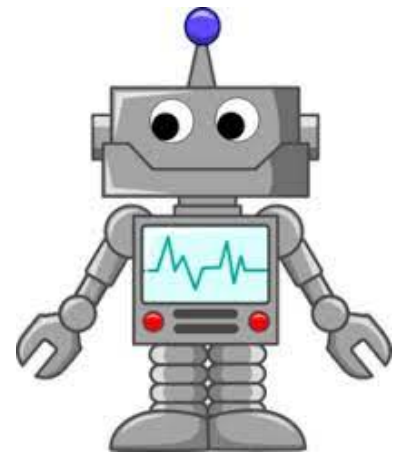
