We are based in the UK so please allow time for us to respond in normal hours UK time.


The red highlighted box below shows the current stock/ticker. Changing this text and pressing enter will load the ticker into the software.



The red highlighted area below is a menu that allows you to choose the individual time unit for the stock/ticker allowing you to choose current recent data with a smaller time unit and larger more historical data with larger time units.



The red highlighted area below is a menu choice of AI behaviour settings starting Sw.When chosen these will highlight onto the stock chart where these behaviours occur. These can be fine tuned with the two sliders in the next screenshot below.



The next highlighted area is where both the Microsoft and AIIR

unique AI models reside.

To use any of them select one from this menu and click on the AI button to the right.

The resulting dots overlay predicts into a future timeframe using past data only.

To clear a previous AI models result you can select Clear AI from this menu.



The next menu selected in red here allows multiple selections of Simple Moving Averages of varying periods.

Additionally this menu allows you to use your own free API key for your own exclusive data usage.



The following slider selected in red allows the user to view an individual time points price and volume from the stock graph.



The following red selected slider is reserved for future use.



The following red selected slider is used to view other parts of the entire stock upto the present.



The following red selected slider allows the user to stretch out or squeeze in more of the stock graph into the visible area. (The default setting is in the middle)



The following red selected area allows viewing vertically for stocks that move up and down sharply.



The following red selected icon is used for drawing lines on any stock chart including support and resistance lines for technical analysis. Select the icon and using the mouse and left button simply select the starting point and the end point.



The following red selected icon is used to remove or delete existing lines drawn. Simply select an end point with the left mouse button.



The following red selected icon toggles between the standard line stock chart and candlesticks(under development).



The following red selected area shows the white lines as AIIR

provides auto AI support and resistance which is updated everytime the user moves the stock chart left or right.



All user drawn lines and essential information is saved on exit with the current ticker/stock symbol.

No data relating to stock prices is saved, all stock data is retrieved live and an internet connection is required for obtaining stock data.
