Cancer is a complex disease and the second leading cause of death globally. Cancer research allows us to find better and more effective ways to prevent, detect, diagnose, treat and ultimately cure cancer.

The Village Walk for Cancer Research was first held in 2002 to honor Midge Bates. Since that time, it has become the largest cancer fundraising event in Hot Springs Village. Over the last 20 years, we have raised more than \$800,000 to support local programs like the “**Seeds of Science**” at the Winthrop P. Rockefeller Cancer Institute for cancer research.
