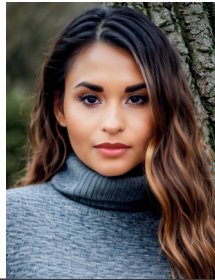

- Exhibits on early electric light and phonograph.

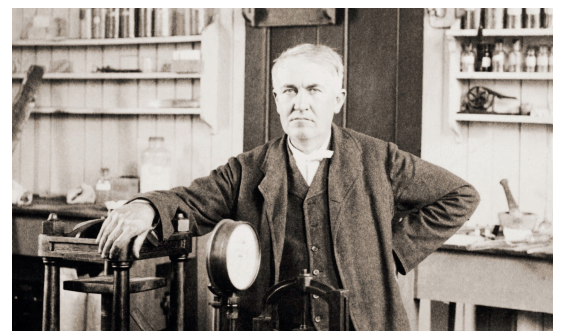

- Visit in late April for the annual Sakura Festival.

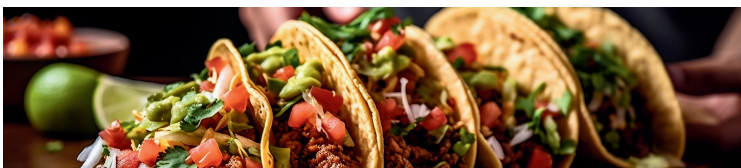

No. 8 Toro Loco

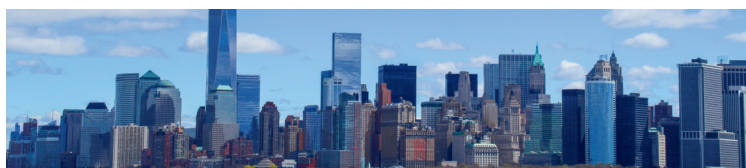
- Vibrant Latin-fusion taquería serving street-style tacos, loaded bowls and inventive margaritas.
