Meeting called to order by Lorryne Ham at 1901,

Mission Statement presented by Randell Rimbey, Marshall at Arms

Randell reported on the court document committee stating the committee is going through all the notes collected from the mock trial. Randell reporting in the last meeting focused on the affirmation process and guidelines for justice interaction decorum.

Steven Warden gave an update on the Recorder process.

Lorryne sharing she is reviewing all of AVR's articles related to jury nullification to gain a better understanding of how that process works. Lorryne creating awareness jury nullification has to be done during a trial when it is determined the law or mandate is not valid.

Lorryne initiating education on what the phrase "jury of peers" represents. She shares jury of peers intentions is to include people who are knowledgeable about the "matter" being adjudicated. Lorryne gave the example of a claimant accusing a healthcare provider misrepresenting themselves and caused harm. The jury of peers would need to consist of healthcare providers and patients. This discussion led into another discussion on types of witnesses that may be part of the court process.
