



## **Virginia General Assembly Meeting Minutes for Tuesday, 8/12/2025**

**Introduction:** Bevins Declaration, Moment of Silence, Mission Statement

### **Agenda Topics:**

- **Vote to Approve minutes from 7/8 GA meeting**
  - Kevin Russell makes the 1<sup>st</sup> move to adopt the minutes, Bradley Odell 2<sup>nd</sup> this move. Minutes adopted!
