REQUIRING RECOGNITION OF THE VIRGINIA ASSEMBLY, UNINCORPORATED AS THE HIGHEST CIVIL AUTHORITY ON VIRGINIA

1. NOTICE OF STANDING AND AUTHORITY

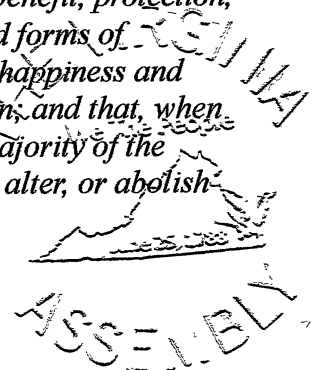
The Virginia Assembly, unincorporated, and the publicly elected organized body politic and instrumentality of the sovereign people on Virginia, on April 1st, 2025, installed in office April 6th, 2025, hereby gives formal Notice of the following:

1. The people on Virginia are confirmed to be the State, an original member of the State of the Union established in 1788
2. The State (capital S) is the unincorporated body politic — the People — holding original sovereignty and territorial jurisdiction on Virginia;
3. The Commonwealth of Virginia/Commonwealth of Virginia is the incorporated governmental service provider created by the People through the Virginia Constitution to administer the public business servicing sixteen (16) enumerated powers given by the State;
4. The Commonwealth of Virginia/Commonwealth of Virginia is **not sovereign**; it exercises **delegated powers only**, as affirmed in Sections 1. 2 and 3 of the Virginia Constitution; Declaration of Rights:

SECTION 1. *That all men are by nature equally free and independent, and have certain inherent rights, of which, when they enter into a state of society, they cannot, by any compact, deprive or divest their posterity, namely, the enjoyment of life and liberty, with the means of acquiring and possessing property, and pursuing and obtaining happiness and safety.*

SECTION 2. *That all power is vested in, and consequently derived from, the people; that magistrates are their trustees and servants, and at all times amenable to them.*

SECTION 3. *That government is, or ought to be, instituted for the common benefit, protection, and security of the people, nation, or community; of all the various modes and forms of government, that is best which is capable of producing the greatest degree of happiness and safety, and is most effectually secured against the danger of maladministration; and that, when any government shall be found inadequate or contrary to these purposes, a majority of the community hath an indubitable, inalienable, and indefeasible right to reform, alter, or abolish it, in such manner as shall be judged most conducive to the public weal.*



5. The premise of the Virginia Constitution and its issuance was created by the sovereign people on Virginia; "By the general assembly" refers to unincorporated General Assembly of The Virginia Assembly, unincorporated now in session;
6. The Virginia Assembly, unincorporated, stands as the **living expression of the people**, the source of all political power, having superior concurrent general jurisdiction, and therefore the **highest authority on Virginia**;

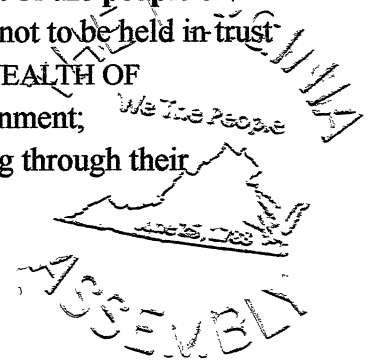
2. LAND AND SOIL JURISDICTION

1. The Land and soil jurisdiction originates in the **people**, not in the corporate Commonwealth of Virginia/COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA nor in the Federal Government dba United States of America, Inc.;
2. Virginia vested sovereignty on the Land and soil jurisdiction in the **inhabitants** — the people — who form the State;
3. The Commonwealth of Virginia/COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA exercises limited territorial jurisdiction **only because the People delegated certain authority** through the Virginia Constitution (1776);
4. The people on Virginia retain:
 - Original sovereignty
 - Allodial possession of land and private property
 - The right to self-govern and direct the contracted governmental service providers
 - The right to assemble and conduct the affairs of the Commonwealth/State of Virginia through the State
 - All unalienable Rights

The Virginia Assembly, unincorporated is the organized sovereign authority through which the People exercise these retained powers;

3. LAND, PROPERTY, AND ADMINISTRATIVE AUTHORITY

1. Land patents and grants secure deed and **title**, and allodial possession secures **ownership**, but neither transfers sovereignty to the Commonwealth of Virginia/COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA;
2. The Commonwealth of Virginia/COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA may administer taxation as consented to by the sovereign people, land regulation, and public services **only under delegated authority** from the People;
3. The corporate Commonwealth of Virginia/COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA, Virginia.gov, and its agencies may **hold or manage public land only in trust to the benefit of the people on Virginia**, not as sovereign owners; private lands owned by the people are not to be held in trust by the Corporate or incorporated Commonwealth of Virginia/COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA, its agencies, or any other variation or style of Corporate government;
4. Sovereignty over Land and soil remains with the people on Virginia, acting through their Assembly;



4. FORMAL REQUIREMENT FOR RECOGNITION

By this Directive, The Virginia Assembly, unincorporated hereby requires that:

1. The Governor, Legislature, and all Departments acknowledge:

- The Virginia Assembly, unincorporated as the **sovereign body politic** on Virginia;
- The distinction between the **State** (the People) and the Commonwealth of Virginia/COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA (the Service Provider);
- That all governmental authority exercised by the Commonwealth of Virginia/COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA is **derivative**, not inherent and conforms and complies to only delegated authority per the Virginia Constitution and the Constitution of the United States of America;

2. All agencies and officers of the Commonwealth of Virginia/COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA, including its Administrative Courts recognize:

- The Virginia Assembly, unincorporated as the **highest authority** on Virginia;
- The people on Virginia retain sovereignty over Land and soil jurisdiction;
- The people's right to self-govern as guaranteed by the Virginia Constitution;
- Administrative Courts DO NOT APPLY to living men/women and jurisdiction is to be respected and honored; This directive must go to all courts, Clerks of Courts, Judiciaries, County Sheriffs, Attorneys/Esquires and Law Enforcement Departments on Virginia;
- Will be educated in the true facts of jurisdiction, authority, and obligation under the Constitution of the United States of America;
 - Courts will cease all compelled Commercial Actions against the living people on Virginia not acting in commerce; example but not limited to:
 - non-commercial traffic infractions;
 - foreclosure for taxation;
 - repossession of property based on fraudulent creation of credit and "lending" practice; example: creation of credit is not turned into currency used by the "buyer" to own, it is created to benefit the bank/financial institution and fraudulently "loaned" to the "buyer" without full disclosure;
- Public records be maintained and presented when requested in their entirety, unredacted, altered, or edited;
- Full sworn accounting of all accounts of the people held by corporations related to territorial and municipal government, courts, banks, utility and service companies, etc., to include both sides of the ledger, both on and off books, in affidavit form, under penalty of perjury, signed, notarized and presented to the people upon request.
- Directives and orders issued to public news services (e.g. The Virginia Pilot, Richmond Times-Dispatch, Roanoke Times, Bristol Herald-Courier, Free Lance-Star, publicly aired television and

radio stations) be withdrawn so as to not violate the rights of the people on Virginia to free speech and a free press;

3. All interactions, current and future, with the people on Virginia respect:

- Their political status and Land and soil jurisdiction; This Jurisdiction is required to be acknowledged in all Commonwealth of Virginia/COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA codes and regulations as well as documents and publications;
- Their standing as the State Authority;
- Their right to assemble and direct their own government as well as the current and future governmental service providers;
- The unalienable rights of declared Americans;

4. RESERVATION OF RIGHTS

The Virginia Assembly, unincorporated, on behalf of the people on Virginia, expressly reserves:

- All unalienable rights;
- All rights secured by the Virginia Constitution;
- All rights retained by the people under the Bill of Rights;
- All rights retained by the people under the Ninth Amendment;
- All rights retained by the People under the Tenth Amendment;
- All rights of self-governance, assembly, land and soil jurisdiction;

Nothing in this Directive shall be construed as a waiver of rights or as consent to any presumption of federal or municipal citizenship, constituency, residency, or franchise participation;

5. CERTIFICATION

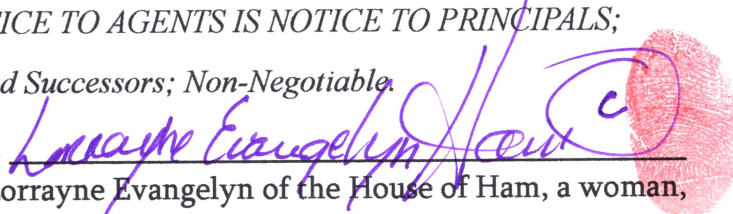
