Mission statement read by marhall at arms, Randell Rimbey

Randell gave a report about the vetting committee - noting document is completed and plan is to bring to general assembly for a vote. Reported on the progress with court documents. He shared the last focus was on role of mediator - working on path from self-governance to mediation to living court. Randell notes draft #4 was sent out to everyone for review. Brief discussion about a 2nd mock trial - noting a civil case and criminal case needs to be done.

Identification the vetting committee needs a third person. The third person will be an alternate. Keving Barry Miller volunteered to be the third person.

Lorrayne noting the court recorder position is still open.

Lorrayne posed some questions for all to ponder which included:

"What is an American", "who am I", "what is a Virginian", "how can we make Virginia better"

Question brought up about having a litigation committee. Kevin Barry Miller reminding everyone there is a litigation call every Thursday at 5pm (time zone not identified)

Thunder Layne creating awareness that the defacto Virginia has passed some new laws - ~12, suggesting everyone should make themselves aware.

Lorrayne shared it was announced in Tuesday podcast that Ohio is fully stood up, their framework is in place. Lorrayne sharing it was shared in the podcast the Cincinnati police force acknowledged the Ohio Assembly stating "American State Nationals in area and to stand down, be prepared to get true directives from our true government".
