

Virginia Assembly Meeting Minutes, January 24, 2023

This meeting was held on Zoom. Attendance will be taken on the Google Drive spreadsheet. We are now using Google Drive to store Assembly documents. Google Drive is by Google and OneDrive is by Microsoft, we use Google Drive.

- The meeting was called to order at 7:06 p EST.

- Tamara read the Bevin's Declaration.

Lorrayne did the Treasury Report

As of December 31, 2022

Balance: \$6,378.46

Total inflow, December 2022, \$144.97, from recordings and I.D. cards

Expenses, December 2022, \$13.34 for Microsoft Teams, not including % for Square

Included in the balance is \$1,325 in Sovereign's Way education funds (\$500 of that has been generously transferred to the general fund of the assembly, and \$797 will be refunded to the benefactor of those monies).

2. Committee Reports (announcements and info). PKTF, New Member Orientation, etc.

Marshall at Arms bridge call. Randell said there was no recent meeting. Steve and he continue to work on describing position duties. The 64 GB scandisk, download has been done and he should get it in the mail soon with 4,000 literary items. David Gaul (sp?), Marshal at Arms from CA put together an election process. They sent it to AVR for review and approval, but she has not yet responded.

3. Q&A after meeting (cut main meeting off at 8:30). This will be for new members with questions. We did not do this tonight because there were no new members on the call at 8:30p.

Old Business

1. Vote to adopt minutes from 1/17/23. Lorrayne put forth a motion to adopt them, Steve seconded it. No nays, no abstentions, Vote was unanimous.
2. Any more old business? No

New Business

1. Do we have a Quorum? Yes
2. Letter for New members: Review. Paper Social this Thursday and for next 3 weeks.
3. Vetting and Vetting Committee?? If we are not doing our jobs, anyone can ask for a re-vote.
4. AVR Monday night call. Some good news. We are making headway. Children's Health Defense Fund, RFK Jr. A Supreme Court ruling in his favor. They changed the definition of vaccine. The case may take away legal immunity. RFK is suing the mainstream media. Sins of omission. Dr. David Martin, Prosecute Now, he is pursuing a criminal case and it

is moving forward. TASA Federation is working in the Air Jurisdiction and is holding the Pope accountable. They are trying to dissolve all the corporations. In order to resume the Jural Assembly meetings we are trying to get the forms from Accomack Anna. We will get her to mail the paperwork to Kevin.

5. We need to get the Jural Assembly up. We need a list of tasks. It is easy, but hard to put together a Jural Assembly. You have to be a Virginia State Citizen to participate. You need a whole new coordinator. We need to raise a court. A Fiduciary Delegate in the Continental Congress needs their ancestry researched and recorded. We need a certain number of members, at least 26-30. Anna is proofing our election process. We have to elect Sheriffs, Justices, Clerks, Marshal at Arms. We will have to send notices out throughout the state and county to all corporate elected officials. We do not need a corporate judge, just a justice. If the energy starts flowing, things will start moving. We may stand up the state jural assembly first though it is preferable to start at the county level. Anna has 13 groups/sections of Virginia that she created. We can do regional issues to start, then once word gets out, more people will want to join. We need to think of the big picture, work backwards, then work small and not be afraid of the process. Let's make a commitment to do it. Sheriffs serve by county, not by state. Marshall at Arms could take the state level position and work with Sheriffs. Troy researched a lot about the Marshall at Arms role. Marshall at Arms can act only within the realm of the court. There is a question whether Electors must be male. AVR corrected the issue of males only and now men, women and people of color are equal and can be Electors. We can do more research.
6. Cheryl wants to start a Notices and Claims Committee.
7. Peacekeeping Task Force report. We tried to get on the call last night but we could not connect so there was no meeting. Friday night Marshall at Arms bridge call. Everybody in every state is putting their own money into this. This is a problem. There needs to be financial help from the Federation. Continental Marshalls are struggling until they get some subsidies to put money into advertising, and compensation. Recruitment remains an issue. His fellow Marshall at Arms, Michelle Ford (?), put out two videos on YouTube how to recruit new members. Two-hour podcast on Tuesdays and Thursdays with Q&A. Randy put in a rough draft of an affirmation but got ideas from other states. It requires two witnesses in a public reading of the person elected. Signatures in blue (wet ink), red thumb print, must be recorded with your County Clerk. An oath is swearing your allegiance to a God or deity whereas an affirmation is you pledging to do your best as a responsible fiduciary. AVR has written a lot about affirmations.
8. Use MOCEE to offset our living expenses. Regulation Z Working Group on Mattermost.
9. Scott, Cheryl and Randy discussed holding a marketing ideas meeting on January 25 at 5p.
