  - Direct Notices to Main Trustees and Secondary Trustees, both Fed and State
  - o Trustee "Areas" 21 areas in all?? There are three Trustees to notify.
  - o Notice of Unlawful Right of Distraint and Levy.
  - o Kevin said with our 928's we need to notify 3 trustees. There is one main one and two secondary Trustees (the two secondary Trustees are in Virginia).
  - We listened to the above link #3 (Monday AVR call) starting at 24:00 minutes.
  - Justin (did the research) and said that the specific authorization for the FBI (Federal Bureau of Investigation) one is municipal, one is territorial, is 28 USC 533. This is what gives them their authority.
  - Go to: www.law.cornell.edu to read the code.

- Many of the alphabet agencies have shifted over to operate under the DOJ. The DOJ is the private corporate council for the executive branch. Their role is to detect and prosecute crimes against the United States. Their role is as part of the corporations, and not the government of the land and soil. It is a subject matter jurisdiction. The U.S. Trustees are at the top of the triad. We need to send notice to the Trustees, they stand above the courts and the alphabet agencies. The Congressional Record on June 13, 1967, page 15,641-46, states that: We are "civilly dead" and have no presumed standing. Combine this with the kidnapping via birth certificates, this is how it all meshes together. 5 USC 101 defines what all the executive departments are. Everything is under the executive branch, there are NO separate branches of government.
