 - d. Civil versus criminal
 - e. Cast which makes up the court system
 - i. Sargeant at Arms
 - ii. Sheriff
 - iii. Coroner
 - iv. Justice
 - v. Court Notary, Court Guarantor, Court Recorder
 - f. Jury
 - g. Grand jury
- D. Additional areas for consideration for the notices for demand for the IBA included sanctuary state matter, Diversity/Exclusion/Inclusion
- E. There was open discussion from attendees surrounding the court process, common law and objectives of common law
- F. Recommendation made to visit the national liberty alliance website as this site gives information on cases that have been processed through this alliance.
