1. **Election Update:** Lorrayne Ham gave an update on our election notice via public announcements. Originally our goal was to publish notices for 5 consecutive weeks prior to the election and 3 weeks post-election. We intended to publish One week in the Richmond Times Dispatch and the other weeks in smaller newspapers. When submitting these notices to the smaller papers, we were quoted aprox. \$30 dollars each. However, upon final approval by the smaller newspapers, the actual amount that they wanted to charge changed to over \$200 each. Due to budget constraints we had an emergency meeting and decided to only post 1x in the Richmond times before the election and 1 x post the election. Emails will continue to be sent weekly to ALL ASN's on Sunday's announcing our elections.

1. At our next general assembly meeting, an update on our election process will be provided by the election committee.

2. Committee Reports

1. **Treasury Report:** N/A Updated provided in previous meeting
2. **Jural Docs Committee:** Randy Rimbey advised the group that we have finalized our court process and handbook procedures. We still have a few items which will need to be ironed out in the future (bonding, capital punishment and our mock trial) We ask that all ASN's please read and review the Jural handbook. If you have questions, comments and feedback, please let Lorrayne or Randy know.
3. **Jural Assembly update:** Lorrayne advised the group that Dominck has stepped up to chair the mock trial committee and the group has come up with a plan of action and will begin working on this after our elections are held on 4/1/25.

4. Peacekeeping task force: Steven Just advised that we don't have any new updates from the peacekeeping task force. He has reached out again to the VA Sherriff's association and the Cambell county militia and has not been able to speak with anyone.

3. Open Topics:

1. Reminder that our elections will be held on 4/1/25 from 4-7 PM via Zoom.
2. Randy Rimbey suggested that all ASN's review the Court procedures and documents so we can vote on these. Several folks agreed and it was decided that the jural Assembly will vote on these procedures on 3/13/25. (pending feedback)
3. Lorrayne mentioned to the group – "Where do we go from here"? We are in kind of a lull period and want to know from the group what the most pressing items that each of us have in regards to building our assembly. Suggestions from the group included:
 1. How do ASN's correspond to the IRS?
 2. What about DMV and traffic stops/violations (Chris Dunlap mentioned that he has several videos and ideas for how to handle traffic stops and said he will forward these to the group)
 3. State level taxes and property taxes
 4. The group decided that we should focus on these via our Internal Business Assembly. This group will meet up soon to brainstorm ideas for who/what/where/how we provide guidance and feedback to the group as well as the De Facto.

If no new business left, Shirley Bryant made a move to reconvene on Tuesday, March 18th of 2025 at 7:00pm EST, this was 2ndd by numerous people.
