Seated Offices include positions that populate Virginia's American Common Law Courts system and Public Office positions for The Virginia Assembly pillars.

Elected people are as follows; Lorrayne Evangelyn Ham-Speaker, Randell Alan Rimbey- Marshal-at-Arms, Patty Roach Rimbey-Treasurer, Kevin Blake Russell-Secretary, Shirley Lanier Smith Bryant-Justice, Kevin Barry Miller-Justice, Scott David Sevart-Court Clerk, Aaron Ashanti-Court Notary, Michael DeMasters-Bondsman, Robert Combs-Coroner, Steven Russell Just-Militia Commander.

A vote was called to approve the above public announcement. The vote passed with 21 yea's and 1 abstaintion.
