- Work Shoes (no open-toed shoes)
- ➤ Work Gloves (marked w/ your name)
- Hammer (marked w/ your name)
- Pain Brush & Plastic Pain Bucket (to give away)
- Water bottle & hat (please use these!)
- ➤ Sunscreen & insect repellent (and these!)
- Pillow/Sleeping Bag/sheets
- Foam/Air Mattress (you may be on a cot)
- Modest Pajamas
- > Towel & toiletries (Definitely use these!!)
- > Bag to tote your shower stuff & clothes in
- > Shower shoes (better safe than grossed out)
- > Needed Prescription medications (inhalers etc.)
- Casual Clothes for evening activities
- An outfit & shoes you could be active in
- > An attitude of gratitude and service

## OTHER IMPORTANT DETAILS: (please read carefully)

- Dress Code... We don't want anything to distract us from God's work! Please, no spaghetti straps or tank-tops; no short shorts or skirts; nothing that would be a distraction for anyone at any time this goes for guys & gals. Some worksites will want to wear pants trust us on this bring some in case. Tennis shoes or work boots are REQUIRED for the work sites.
- Some of you may be sleeping on the cot in the motel. Bring sleeping bags or sheets so that you'll sleep well! You will still be grouped in a room with others from your church.
- Bring your own towels and washcloths. The hotel DOES NOT provide these. You may want to bring a bag to carry your shower stuff.
- Please keep any use of electrical devices, especially CELL PHONES, to a minimum. NO CELL PHONES on worksites. ROL is a special time set-apart from our normal world for spiritual renewal and so is a cell-phone free event! We are asking you to leave them and any other distracting devices at home. If you need to call home to check in with your parents, just ask your team/youth leaders, they will have theirs for such situations. We understand how difficult this request is but we trust that you will be able to put the good of our group over your own comforts.
- You are going to be working with students from other churches! Be excited about that because it means you're about to have a new bunch of friends. You will always be put with at least one other person from your church, so don't worry! Even now, begin praying for these people that you don't know and for the work site family you will serve. God digs that!
- The tools on the "what to bring" list above may be used by you or someone else. If you would like to donate them to the ROL tool corral then don't worry about marking them, and thank you for the donation! If you need to bring them back home with you be sure to mark them well. (The more quality paint brushes you can bring, the better!)
