Scripture Reference: 1 Samuel 18: 1-14

Overview: Envy is one of societies biggest problems. What is it? And, what can we do about it?

10. Sermon Name: Friendship

Scripture Reference: 1 Samuel 18,19,20,23

Overview: The importance of friendship. The elements of friendship. An example of friendship.

11. Sermon Name: King David's Sins

Scripture Reference: 2 Samuel 11 & 12

Overview: No matter what our condition sin always lies at our doorstep.

12. Sermon Name: Traditional Beliefs

Scripture Reference: 1 Kings 17: 7-24

Overview: What can we learn from the story of Elijah and the widow woman.

13. Sermon Name: Elijah vs Baal

Scripture Reference: Exodus 3: 1-14

Overview: Most people believe in God, but do they have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ?

26. Sermon Name: Sin

Scripture Reference: Genesis 2: 16-17, 3: 1-9

Overview: Sin is the fundamental problem facing the human race. Explore the root and evidence of sin. How it affects us and God's response to our condition.

27. Sermon Name: Humility

Scripture Reference: Philippians 2: 1-11

Overview: What causes divisions? How do you find and obtain a heart for peace? Why is the Christian life like a baseball game?

28. Sermon Name: Salvation

Scripture Reference: Ephesians 1: 3-10

Overview: We have been blessed with all spiritual blessings in Christ. What are some of these blessings and how do they become a reality in our lives?

29. Sermon Name: Holy Spirit

Scripture Reference: John 14: 15-26

Overview: Is the Holy Spirit really so mysterious? Who is the Holy Spirit? What does He do? And, how can we receive the wonderful ministry of the Holy Spirit.

30. Sermon Name: The Church

Scripture Reference: Ephesians 2: 11-22

Overview: What is the church doing today? Is it the inspirational church described in the Bible? What's the problem and the solution?

Scripture Reference: Rev 21: 1-6, 22: 1-5

Overview: On this most important day of the year, we ask an important question, "Why would you want to become a Christian?"

32. Sermon Name: Money

Scripture Reference: Proverbs

Overview: Why does money have such a hold over us and how do we break its power?

33. Sermon Name: Rich Young Ruler

Scripture Reference: Luke 18: 18-30

Overview: Money can be spiritually dangerous and lead to a salvation by works mentality.

34. Sermon Name: A Heart for Giving

Scripture Reference: 2 Corinthians 8: 8-15

Overview: Giving is not a commandment, but a blessing. With Christ as our example we can reap the benefits of a heart for giving.

Overview: Why does Matthew start his gospel with Jesus' genealogy?

40. Sermon Name: Death

Scripture Reference: 1 Thessalonians 4: 13-18

Overview: How does one have the courage to face death? The Apostle Paul says we need to consider this question and be comforted.

41. Sermon Name: Substitutionary Sacrifice

Scripture Reference: Isaiah 52:13 – 53:12

Overview: Isaiah 52 and 53 give a vivid presentation of Jesus Christ. What can we learn about ourselves by studying Him?

42. Sermon Name: Crucified with Christ

Scripture Reference: Galatians 2: 11-21

Overview: Christ lives in me and I live by faith in the Son of God. Do you believe it and do you express it?

43. Sermon Name: Spiritual Thirst

Scripture Reference: John 4: 6-26

Overview: Jesus explains Spiritual thirst by an encounter with a Samaritan woman at Jacob's well.

44. Sermon Name: Testimony

Scripture Reference: John 4: 27-42

Overview: What is the best way to spread the gospel? Some would say, "Give your testimony." That's what the women in John 4: 29 did.

45. Sermon Name: July 4th, Independence Day

Scripture Reference: Matthew 5: 11-16

Overview: Role of the Church: love and justice, salt and light, a city on a hill

46. Sermon Name: Work

Scripture Reference: Isaiah 60

Overview: How can we integrate our faith into our work?

47. Sermon Name: Held Captive

Scripture Reference: Jeremiah 29: 1-14

Overview: Are Christians being held captive by a secular society? If so, how are we supposed to react?

48. Sermon Name: God's Justice

Scripture Reference: Psalm 58

Overview: God's justice includes accusation, vengeance and rejoicing. A subject that is little talked about in modern society today.

49. Sermon Name: Glory, Gifts, Grace

Scripture Reference: 1 Peter 2: 4-10

Overview: How do you make God's love and justice a reality in your life? Try glory, gifts, grace.

50. Sermon Name: Love

Scripture Reference: 1 Corinthians 13: 1-13

Overview: 1 Corinthians 13: 4-7 is best known for being part of a wedding ceremony. Listen and see if the Apostle Paul had something else in mind.

51. Sermon Name: Patience and Forgiveness

Scripture Reference: Romans 12: 9-21

Overview: Is Christianity growing in quantity but lacking in quality? Patience and forgiveness are powers associated with a supernaturally changed heart.

52. Sermon Name: Suffering

Scripture Reference: Romans 8: 16-28

Overview: Secular society tries to create their own reality to avoid suffering. As Christians we need to understand suffering and how to deal with it.

53. Sermon Name: Rejoice

Scripture Reference: Philippians 4: 4-12

Overview: Is it possible to enter a state of rejoicing even in the midst of suffering?

54. Sermon Name: Humility

Scripture Reference: 1 Corinthians 3: 21 -23, 4: 1-7

Overview: How can we best express our love for others? One way is through humility.

55. Sermon Name: Self- Control

Scripture Reference: 1 Corinthians 9: 23-27, 10: 11-13

Overview: In Galatians 5: 22-23 we read about the Fruit of the Spirit. One of the fruit is temperance (self-control). We need self-control to reach our potential in Christ.

Scripture Reference: Ephesians 4: 14-15, 25-32

Overview: Do you sometimes think you are receiving facts, but those facts are meant to deceive? Ephesians 4: 15 instructs to tell the truth in love.

Overview: As a society do many no longer acknowledge the "Doctrine of Original Sin"? Let's review Genesis 3. You decide.

Overview: Do we need a Biblical perspective to face trials and temptations?

Overview: James' last instruction to the Jewish believers was relationship. Come together, help each other, depend on Jesus.

Overview: Jesus: Who is He and what did He come to earth to do?

Scripture Reference: John 12: 27-36

Overview: What is God's glory? Where is it found? How can we demonstrate it to the world?

70. Sermon Name: Jesus' Last Sermon

Scripture Reference: John 12 37-50

Overview: Are we getting a watered down version of the Gospel? In John 12, Jesus tells it like it is.

71. Sermon Name: True Freedom

Scripture Reference: John 8: 31-36, 56-59

Overview: Today's culture and Jesus have differing views when it comes to the subject of freedom. Listen and see which freedom most appeals to you.

72. Sermon Name: Bold or Merciful

Scripture Reference: John 13: 1-5

Overview: When are we to be bold and when more merciful? Jesus was both. What was the power behind his actions?

73. Sermon Name: Peter's Arrogance

Scripture Reference: John 13: 6-10

Overview: Using Peter as an example, Jesus shows humanity's problem and the solution to the problem.

Scripture Reference: John 13: 12-17

Overview: We are to share the love of God. His love involves sacrifice on the front end but produces blessings on the back end.

Overview: Scripture is about Jesus and fulfilled by Jesus. Scripture teaches us how to face adversity

Scripture Reference: John 13: 21-30

Overview: What is the nature of sin? What is the power of sin? How can we overcome sin?

Scripture Reference: John 13: 31-36

Overview: What is glory of the Lord? How do we enter into his glory and become his disciples?

Scripture Reference: Luke 24: 36-43

Overview: Easter teaches us that Jesus is Lord and shows us a new way to live.

79. Sermon Name: Peter

Scripture Reference: John 13: 33-38

Overview: What can we learn by studying Peter's three denials of Jesus?

Scripture Reference: John 1: 1-11

Overview: Seven times in the first few verses of John 1, Jesus is referring to "as a light." Does the world need "a light"? If so, how do we get this "light".

Overview: Jesus assures us of His joy. It is supernatural and much better than any joy this world can offer.
