The Gospel, According to Matthew

- Mat 6:33 "But seek ye first The Kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you."
- Mat 12:28 "But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then The Kingdom of God is come unto you."
- **Mat 19:24** "And again I say unto you, It is <u>easier</u> for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into **The Kingdom of God.**"
- **Mat 21:31** "Whether of them twain did the <u>will</u> of *his* father? They say unto him, The first. Jesus saith unto them, Verily I say unto you, That the publicans and the harlots **go into The Kingdom of God before** you."
- **Mat 21:43** "Therefore say I unto you, **The Kingdom of God** shall be <u>taken</u> from you, and <u>given to</u> a nation <u>bringing</u> forth the fruits thereof."

The Gospel, According to Mark

- Mark 1:14-15 "Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, <u>preaching the gospel of</u> The Kingdom of God, {15} And saying, The time is fulfilled, and The Kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel."
- **Mark 4:11** "And he said unto them, Unto you it is given to know the mystery of **The Kingdom of God:** but unto them that are without, all *these* things are done in parables:"
- Mark 4:26 "And he said, So is The Kingdom of God, as if a man should cast seed into the ground;"
- Mark 4:30 "And he said, Whereunto shall we liken **The Kingdom of God?** or with what comparison shall we compare it?"
- **Mark 9:1** "And he said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That there be some of them that stand here, which shall not taste of death, **until** they have seen **The Kingdom of God** come with power."
- **Mark 9:47** "And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out: it is better for thee to enter into **The Kingdom of God** with one eye, than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire:"
- **Mark 10:14-15** *{13}* "And they brought young children to him, that he should touch them: and *his* disciples rebuked those that brought *them. {14}* But when Jesus saw *it,* he was much displeased, and said unto them, 'Suffer the little children to come unto me, and forbid them not: for of such is **The Kingdom of God.** *{15}* Verily I say unto you, Whosoever shall not receive **The Kingdom of God** as a little child, he shall not enter therein.' *{16}* And he took them up in his arms, put *his* hands upon them, and blessed them."
- **Mark 10:23-25** "And Jesus looked round about, and saith unto his disciples, How hardly shall they that have riches enter into **The Kingdom of God!** {24} And the disciples were astonished at his words. But Jesus answereth again, and saith unto them, Children, how hard is it for them that trust in riches to enter into **The Kingdom of God!** {25} It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into **The Kingdom of God.**"
- **Mark 12:34** "And when Jesus saw that he answered discreetly, he said unto him, Thou art not far from **The Kingdom of God.** And no man after that durst ask him *any question.*"
- **Mark 14:25** "Verily I say unto you, I will drink no more of the fruit of the vine, **until that day** that I drink it new in **The Kingdom of God."**

Mark 15:43 "Joseph of Arimathaea, an honourable counsellor, which also waited for **The Kingdom of God**, came, and went in boldly unto Pilate, and craved the body of Jesus."

The Gospel, According to Luke

- Luke 4:43 "And he said unto them, I must preach The Kingdom of God to other cities also: for therefore am I sent."
- Luke 6:20 "And he lifted up his eyes on his disciples, and said, Blessed be ye poor: for yours is The Kingdom of God."
- **Luke 7:28** "For I say unto you, Among those that are born of women there is not a greater prophet than John the Baptist: but he that is least in **The Kingdom of God** is greater than he."
- **Luke 8:1** "And it came to pass afterward, that he went throughout every city and village, preaching and showing the glad tidings of **The Kingdom of God:** and the twelve *were* with him,"
- **Luke 8:10** "And he said, Unto you it is given to know the mysteries of **The Kingdom of God:** but to others in parables; that seeing they might not see, and hearing they might not understand."
- Luke 9:2 "And he sent them to preach The Kingdom of God, and to heal the sick."
- **Luke 9:11** "And the people, when they knew *it,* followed him: and he received them, and spake unto them of **The Kingdom of God,** and healed them that had need of healing."
- **Luke 9:27** "But I tell you of a truth, there be some standing here, which shall not taste of death, **until** they see **The Kingdom of God."**
- Luke 9:60 "Jesus said unto him, Let the dead bury their dead: but go thou and preach The Kingdom of God."
- **Luke 9:62** "And Jesus said unto him, No man, having put his hand to the plow, and looking back, is fit for **The Kingdom of God."**
- Luke 10:9 "And heal the sick that are therein, and say unto them, The Kingdom of God is come nigh unto you."
- **Luke 10:11** "Even the very dust of your city, which cleaveth on us, we do wipe off against you: notwithstanding be ye sure of this, that **The Kingdom of God is come nigh unto** you."
- Luke 11:20 "But if I with the finger of God cast out devils, no doubt The Kingdom of God is come upon you."
- Luke 12:31 "But rather seek ye The Kingdom of God; and all these things shall be added unto you."
- **Luke 12:32 "Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you The Kingdom."
- Luke 13:18 "Then said he, Unto what is The Kingdom of God like? and whereunto shall I resemble it?"
- Luke 13:20 "And again he said, Whereunto shall I liken The Kingdom of God?"
- **Luke 13:28-29** "There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when ye shall see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets, in **The Kingdom of God,** and you *yourselves* thrust out. *{29}* And they shall come from the east, and *from* the west, and from the north, and *from* the south, and shall sit down in **The Kingdom of God.**"
- **Luke 14:15** "And when one of them that sat at meat with him heard these things, he said unto him, Blessed *is* he that shall eat bread in **The Kingdom of God.**"
- **Luke 16:16** "The law and the prophets *were* until John: **since that time The Kingdom of God** is preached, and every man presseth into it."

- **Luke 17:20-21** "And when he was demanded of the Pharisees, when **The Kingdom of God** should come, he answered them and said, **The Kingdom of God** <u>cometh not with observation</u>: {21} Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, **The Kingdom of God** <u>is within</u> you."
- **Luke 18:16-17** "But Jesus called them *unto him,* and said, Suffer little children to come unto me, and forbid them not: for of such is **The Kingdom of God.** *{17}* Verily I say unto you, Whosoever shall not receive **The Kingdom of God** as a little child shall in no wise enter therein."
- **Luke 18:24-25** "And when Jesus saw that he was very sorrowful, he said, How hardly shall they that have riches enter into **The Kingdom of God!** *{25}* For it is easier for a camel to go through a needle's eye, than for a rich man to enter into **The Kingdom of God.**"
- **Luke 18:29** "And he said unto them, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or parents, or brethren, or wife, or children, for **The Kingdom of God's** sake,"
- **Luke 19:11** "And as they heard these things, he added and spake a parable, because he was nigh to Jerusalem, and because they thought that **The Kingdom of God** should **immediately** appear."
- **Luke 19:15 "And it came to pass, that when he was returned, having received **The Kingdom,** then he commanded these servants to be called unto him, to whom he had given the money, that he might know how much every man had gained by trading."
- **Luke 21:31** "So likewise ye, when ye see these things come to pass, know ye that **The Kingdom of God** is **nigh at hand**."
- Luke 22:16 "For I say unto you, I will not any more eat thereof, until it be fulfilled in The Kingdom of God."
- Luke 22:18 "For I say unto you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine, until The Kingdom of God shall come."
- **Luke 23:51** "(The same had not consented to the counsel and deed of them;) *he was* of Arimathaea, a city of the Jews: who also himself waited for **The Kingdom of God.**"

The Gospel, According to John

- **John 3:3** "Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see **The Kingdom of God."**
- **John 3:5** "Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and *of* the Spirit, he cannot enter into **The Kingdom of God."**

The Acts of the Apostles

- **Acts 1:3** "To whom also he showed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and <u>speaking</u> of the things pertaining to **The Kingdom of God:"**
- **Acts 1:6 "When they therefore were come together, they asked of him, saying, Lord, wilt thou at this time restore again **The Kingdom** to Israel?"
- **Acts 8:12** "But when they believed Philip <u>preaching</u> the things <u>concerning</u> **The Kingdom of God,** and <u>the name of</u> Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women."
- **Acts 14:22** "Confirming the souls of the disciples, *and* exhorting them to continue in the faith, and that <u>we must through much tribulation enter</u> into **The Kingdom of God."**

- **Acts 19:8** "And he went into the synagogue, and spake boldly for the space of three months, <u>disputing</u> and <u>persuading</u> the things <u>concerning</u> **The Kingdom of God.**"
- Acts 20:25 "And now, behold, I know that ye all, among whom I have gone <u>preaching</u> The Kingdom of God, shall see my face no more."
- **Acts 28:23** "And when they had appointed him a day, there came many to him into *his* lodging; to whom he <u>expounded</u> and <u>testified</u> **The Kingdom of God,** persuading them <u>concerning Jesus</u>, both out of the law of Moses, and *out of* the prophets, from morning till evening."
- **Acts 28:31** "Preaching The Kingdom of God, and teaching those things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ, with all confidence, no man forbidding him."

Paul's Epistles

- **Rom 14:17** "For **The Kingdom of God** is <u>not meat and drink</u>; but <u>righteousness</u>, and <u>peace</u>, and <u>joy in the Holy</u> Ghost."
- **1 Cor 4:20** "For **The Kingdom of God** *is* not in word, but in power."
- **1 Cor 6:9-10** "Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not <u>inherit</u> **The Kingdom of God?** Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, *{10}* Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall <u>inherit</u> **The Kingdom of God.**"
- **1 Cor 15:24 "Then *cometh* the end, when he shall have delivered up **The Kingdom** to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power."
- **1 Cor 15:50** "Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot <u>inherit</u> **The Kingdom of God**; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption."
- **Gal 5:21** "Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told *you* in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit **The Kingdom of God."**
- **Eph 5:5 "For this ye know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in **The Kingdom of Christ and of God**."
- **Col 1:13 "Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated *us* into **The Kingdom of His Dear Son**:"
- **Col 4:11** "And Jesus, which is called Justus, who are of the circumcision. These only *are my* fellowworkers unto **The Kingdom of God**, which have been a comfort unto me."
- **1 Th 2:12 "That ye would walk worthy of God, who hath called you unto His Kingdom and glory."
- **2 Th 1:5** "Which is a manifest token of the righteous judgment of God, that ye may be counted worthy of **The Kingdom of God**, for which ye also suffer:"
- **2 Tim 4:1** "I charge *thee* therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and **His Kingdom**;"
- **2 Tim 4:18** "And the Lord shall deliver me from every evil work, and will preserve *me* unto **His Heavenly Kingdom**: to whom *be* glory for ever and ever. Amen."
- **Rev 1:9 "I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in **The Kingdom** and patience **of Jesus Christ**, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ."

Rev 12:10 "And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and **The Kingdom of our God**, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night."
