NT Only - 13

Matthew 5:22

But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother shall be guilty before the court; and whoever says to his brother, 'You good-for-nothing,' shall be guilty before the supreme court; and whoever says, 'You fool,' shall be guilty enough to go into the fiery HELL.

Matthew 5:29

If your right eye makes you stumble, tear it out and throw it from you; for it is better for you to lose one of the parts of your body, than for your whole body to be thrown into HELL.

Matthew 5:30

If your right hand makes you stumble, cut it off and throw it from you; for it is better for you to lose one of the parts of your body, than for your whole body to go into HELL.

Matthew 10:28

Do not fear those who kill the body but are unable to kill the soul; but rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in HELL.

Matthew 18:9

If your eye causes you to stumble, pluck it out and throw it from you. It is better for you to enter life with one eye, than to have two eyes and be cast into the fiery HELL.

Matthew 23:15

"Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites, because you travel around on sea and land to make one proselyte; and when he becomes one, you make him twice as much a son of HELL as yourselves.

Matthew 23:33

You serpents, you brood of vipers, how will you escape the sentence of HELL?

Mark 9:43

If your hand causes you to stumble, cut it off; it is better for you to enter life crippled, than, having your two hands, to go into HELL, into the unquenchable fire,

Mark 9:45

If your foot causes you to stumble, cut it off; it is better for you to enter life lame, than, having your two feet, to be cast into HELL,

Mark 9:47

If your eye causes you to stumble, throw it out; it is better for you to enter the kingdom of God with one eye, than, having two eyes, to be cast into HELL,

Luke 12:5

But I will warn you whom to fear: fear the One who, after He has killed, has authority to cast into HELL; yes, I tell you, fear Him!

James 3:6

And the tongue is a fire, the very world of iniquity; the tongue is set among our members as that which defiles the entire body, and sets on fire the course of our life, and is set on fire by HELL.

2 Peter 2:4

For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but cast them into HELL and committed them to pits of darkness, reserved for judgment;

Psalm 6:5

Psalm 9:17

The wicked will return to SHEOL, *Even* all the

Psalm 16:10

For You will not abandon my soul to SHEOL; Nor  
will You allow Your Holy One to undergo decay.

Psalm 18:5

The cords of SHEOL surrounded me; The snares of  
death confronted me.

Psalm 30:3

O LORD, You have brought up my soul  
from SHEOL; You have kept me alive, that I would  
not go down to the pit.

Psalm 31:17

Let me not be put to shame, O LORD, for I call upon  
You; Let the wicked be put to shame, let them be  
silent in SHEOL.

Psalm 49:14

As sheep they are appointed for SHEOL; Death  
shall be their shepherd; And the upright shall rule  
over them in the morning, And their form shall be  
for SHEOL to consume So that they have no  
habitation.

Psalm 49:15

But God will redeem my soul from the power  
of SHEOL, For He will receive me. Selah.

Psalm 55:15

Let death come deceitfully upon them; Let them go  
down alive to SHEOL, For evil is in their dwelling,  
in their midst.

Psalm 86:13

For Your lovingkindness toward me is great, And  
You have delivered my soul from the depths  
of SHEOL.

Psalm 88:3

For my soul has had enough troubles, And my life  
has drawn near to SHEOL.

Psalm 89:48

What man can live and not see death? Can he  
deliver his soul from the power of SHEOL? Selah.

Psalm 116:3

The cords of death encompassed me And the terrors  
of SHEOL came upon me; I found distress and  
sorrow.

Psalm 139:8

If I ascend to heaven, You are there; If I make my  
bed in SHEOL, behold, You are there.

Psalm 141:7

As when one plows and breaks open the earth, Our  
bones have been scattered at the mouth of SHEOL.
