

Anger and Justice

Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath. Eph 4:26

It is possible to be angry and not to sin in your response. Sometimes a person is angry because they see an obvious injustice and no one is doing anything about it.

Eight Bible translations or versions refer to a coming Justice in Isaiah 45:8. For the Christian believer every injustice will be revealed in this life or in the next when Jesus reigns physically on the earth. Then the hunger for Justice will be fulfilled. But some cannot wait that long. We should usually wait.

For the Father judges no man, but has committed all judgment unto the Son. Jn. 5:22

Heavens above, rain down JUSTICE; let the clouds pour it down. Let the earth open, so that salvation springs up, and JUSTICE sprouts with it. I, *ADONAI*, have created it.

Tell the heavens to send down JUSTICE like showers of rain. Prepare the earth for my saving power to sprout and produce JUSTICE that I, the LORD, create.

Drop down dew, ye heavens, from above, and let the clouds rain the just: let the earth be opened, and bud forth a saviour: and let JUSTICE spring up together: I the Lord have created him.

Ye heavens send the dew from above, and let the clouds drop down righteousness: let the earth open, and let salvation and JUSTICE grow forth: let it bring them forth together: I the Lord have created him.

I will send victory from the sky like rain; the earth will open to receive it and will blossom with freedom and JUSTICE. I, the LORD, will make this happen.”

Let JUSTICE descend, you heavens, like dew from above, like gentle rain let the clouds drop it down. Let the earth open and salvation bud forth; let righteousness spring up with them! I, the LORD, have created this.

Rain down, O heavens, from above, and let the clouds pour down JUSTICE. Let the earth open up, let salvation sprout, and righteousness spring up with it. *ADONAI*, have created it.

Skies above, open up and let the clouds rain down righteousness! Let the earth below sprout triumph and JUSTICE. For I, the Eternal, have created them.
