Martha knew something. (All scriptural Jews in Jesus' day knew this.)

Jesus said unto her, Your brother shall rise again.

Martha said unto him, I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day. Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live." (John 11:23-25)

Matthew 22:23

The same day came to him the Sadducees, which say that there is no **resurrection**, and asked him, **Matthew 22:28** Therefore in the **resurrection** whose wife shall she be of the seven? for they all had her. **Matthew 22:30** For in the **resurrection** they neither marry, nor are given in marriage, but are as the angels of God in heaven. **Matthew 22:31** But as touching the **resurrection** of the dead, have ye not read that which was spoken unto you by God, saying, **Matthew 27:53** And came out of the graves after his **resurrection**, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many.

Mark 12:18

Then come unto him the Sadducees, which say there is no **resurrection**; and they asked him, saying,

Beginning from the baptism of John, unto that same day that he was taken up from us, must one be ordained to be a witness with us of his **resurrection**.

And when they heard of the **resurrection** of the dead, some mocked: and others said, We will hear thee again of this matter.

Acts 23:6

But when Paul perceived that the one part were Sadducees, and the other Pharisees, he cried out in the council, Men and brethren, I am a Pharisee, the son of a Pharisee: of the hope and **resurrection** of the dead I am called in question.

Acts 23:8

For the Sadducees say that there is no resurrection, neither angel, nor spirit: but the Pharisees confess both.

Acts 24:15

And have hope toward God, which they themselves also allow, that there shall be a **resurrection** of the dead, both of the just and unjust.

Acts 24:21

Except it be for this one voice, that I cried standing among them, Touching the **resurrection** of the dead I am called in question by you this day.

Romans 1:4

And declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the **resurrection** from the dead:

Romans 6:5

For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his **resurrection**:

1 Corinthians 15:12

Now if Christ be preached that he rose from the dead, how say some among you that there is no **resurrection** of the dead?

1 Corinthians 15:13

But if there be no **resurrection** of the dead, then is Christ not risen:

1 Corinthians 15:21

For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead.

1 Corinthians 15:42

So also is the **resurrection** of the dead. It is sown in corruption; it is raised in incorruption:

Philippians 3:10

That I may know him, and the power of his **resurrection**, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death;

Philippians 3:11

If by any means I might attain unto the resurrection of the dead.

2 Timothy 2:18

Who concerning the truth have erred, saying that the **resurrection** is past already; and overthrow the faith of some.

Hebrews 6:2

Of the doctrine of baptisms, and of laying on of hands, and of **resurrection** of the dead, and of eternal judgment.

Hebrews 11:35

Women received their dead raised to life again: and others were tortured, not accepting deliverance; that they might obtain a better **resurrection**:

1 Peter 1:3

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the **resurrection** of Jesus Christ from the dead,

1 Peter 3:21

The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the **resurrection** of Jesus Christ:

Revelation 20:5

But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection.

Revelation 20:6

Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first **resurrection**: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.

Fire Scriptures

Matthew 5:22

But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou

fool, shall be in danger of hell **fire**.

Matthew 25:41

Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting **fire**, prepared for the devil and his angels:

1 Corinthians 3:15

If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by **fire**. **2 Peter 3:7**

But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto **fire** against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.

2 Peter 3:12

Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on **fire** shall be

dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?

Jude 1:7

Even as Sodom and Gomorrha, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal **fire**.

Revelation 14:10

The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with **fire** and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:

Revelation 19:20

And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of **fire** burning with brimstone.

Revelation 20:10

And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of **fire** and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

Revelation 20:14

And death and hell were cast into the lake of **fire**. This is the second death. **Revelation 20:15**

And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of **fire**. **Revelation 21:8**

But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with **fire** and brimstone: which is the second death.
