The so-called Manifestations of The Holy Spirit are listed in I Corinthians 12, there are nine of them. They can be divided more or less into 3 groups of 3 as follows:

<sup>4</sup> There are diversities of <u>gifts</u>, but the same Spirit.
<sup>5</sup> There are differences of <u>ministries</u>, but the same Lord.
<sup>5</sup> The Lord Jesus assigns the ministries.
<sup>6</sup> And there are diversities of <u>activities (operations)</u>, but it is the <u>same God</u> who works all in all.
The Heavenly Father works through anyone who will let him.

<sup>7</sup> But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the <u>profit of all</u>:
<sup>8</sup> for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit,
to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit,
<sup>9</sup> to another faith by the same Spirit,
to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit,
<sup>10</sup> to another the working of miracles,
to another prophecy,
to another discerning of spirits,
to another different kinds of tongues,
to another the interpretation of tongues.
<sup>11</sup> But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually <u>as He wills.</u> I Cor 12:4-11 NKJV

## Mind:

Word of Wisdom – how to live and to act. Eph. 5:15 Word of Knowledge – facts about situations and people. Jn.4:18 Discernment of (evil) spirits – Is it a demon? Acts 16:16-18

Mouth: Unknown Tongues Acts 19:6 Interpretation of Tongues Dan. 5:26-28 Prophecy Acts 19:6

Hands: Healing Acts 28:8 Miracles Acts 14:3 Faith I Cor. 12:9
