Psalm 5:5-6 (NASB)

⁵ The boastful shall not stand before Your eyes;

You hate all who do iniquity.

⁶ You destroy those who speak falsehood;

The LORD abhors the man of bloodshed and deceit.

Psalm 5:10 (NASB)

¹⁰ Hold them guilty, O God;

By their own devices let them fall!

In the multitude of their transgressions thrust them out,

For they are rebellious against You.

Psalm 10:15 (NASB)

¹⁵ Break the arm of the wicked and the evildoer,

[a] Seek out his wickedness until You find none.

Psalm 17:13 (NASB)

¹³ Arise, O LORD, confront him, bring him low;

Deliver my soul from the wicked with Your sword,

Psalm 35:4-6 (NASB)

⁴Let those be ashamed and dishonored who seek my ^[a]life;

Let those be turned back and humiliated who devise evil against me.

⁵ Let them be like chaff before the wind,

With the angel of the LORD driving *them* on.

⁶Let their way be dark and slippery,

With the angel of the LORD pursuing them.

Psalm 35:8 (NASB)

⁸Let destruction come upon him unawares, And let the net which he hid catch himself;

maliciously.

Psalm 35:26 (NASB)

 26 Let those be a shamed and humiliated altogether

who rejoice at my distress;

Let those be clothed with shame and dishonor

who magnify themselves over me.

Psalm 58:6-9 (NASB)

⁶O God, shatter their teeth in their mouth;

Break out the fangs of the young lions, O LORD.

⁷Let them flow away like water that runs off;

When he [a] aims his arrows, let them be

as [b] headless shafts.

⁸ Let them be as a snail which ^[c] melts away as it

goes along,

Like the miscarriages of a woman which never see

the sun.

⁹ Before your pots can feel *the fire of* thorns

the ^[d]green and the burning alike.

Psalm 59:5 (NASB)

Psalm 59:8 (NASB)

⁸But You, O LORD, laugh at them;

You scoff at all the nations.

Psalm 59:10-14 (NASB)

¹⁰ [a] My God in His lovingkindness will meet me;

God will let me look *triumphantly* upon ^[b]my foes.

¹¹ Do not slay them, or my people will forget;

^[c]Scatter them by Your power, and bring them down.

O Lord, our shield.

¹² [d] On account of the sin of their mouth and the words of their lips,

Let them even be caught in their pride,

And on account of curses and ^[e]lies which they utter.

¹³ [f] Destroy *them* in wrath, ^[g] destroy *them* that they may be no more;

That *men* may know that God ^[h]rules in Jacob To the ends of the earth. *Selah*.

Psalm 69:24-28 (NASB)

²⁴ Pour out Your indignation on them,

And may Your burning anger overtake them.

²⁵ May their ^[a]camp be desolate;

May none dwell in their tents.

Psalm 79:6 (NASB)

⁶ Pour out Your wrath upon the nations which do not know You,

And upon the kingdoms which do not call upon Your name.

Psalm 79:12 (NASB)

¹² And return to our neighbors sevenfold into their bosom

[a] The reproach with which they have reproached You, O Lord.

Psalm 109:6-19 (NASB)

⁶ Appoint a wicked man over him,

And let an [a] accuser stand at his right hand.

⁷ When he is judged, let him come forth guilty, And let his prayer become sin.

⁸Let his days be few;

Let another take his office.

⁹Let his children be fatherless

And his wife a widow.

¹⁰Let his children wander about and beg;

And let them seek *sustenance* [b] far from their ruined homes.

¹¹Let the creditor ^[c] seize all that he has,

And let strangers plunder the product of his labor.
