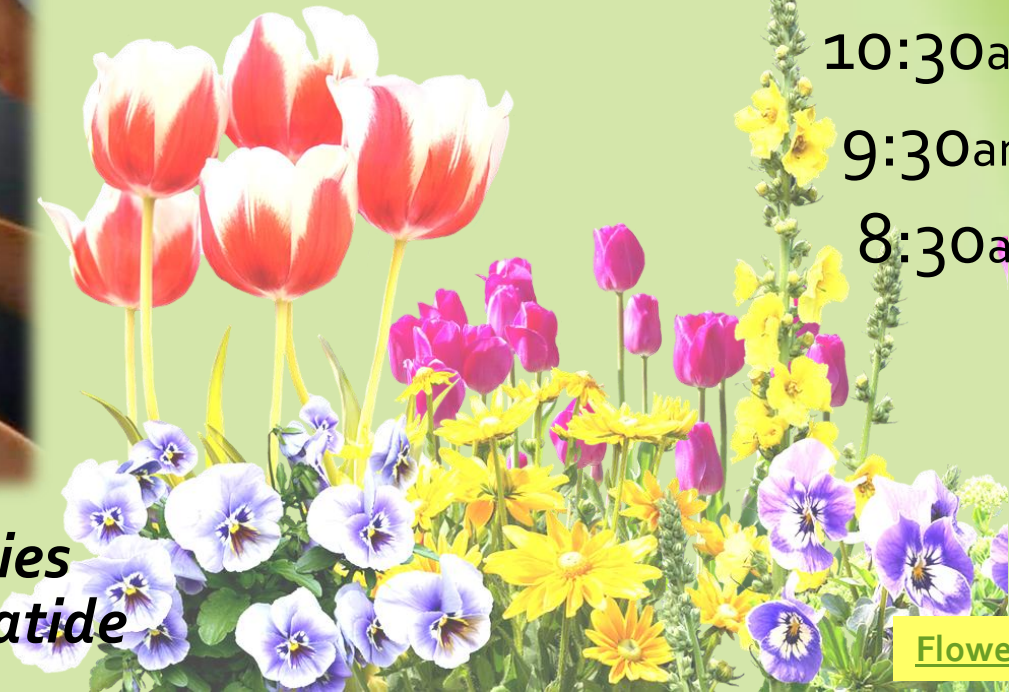

made heaven & earth.

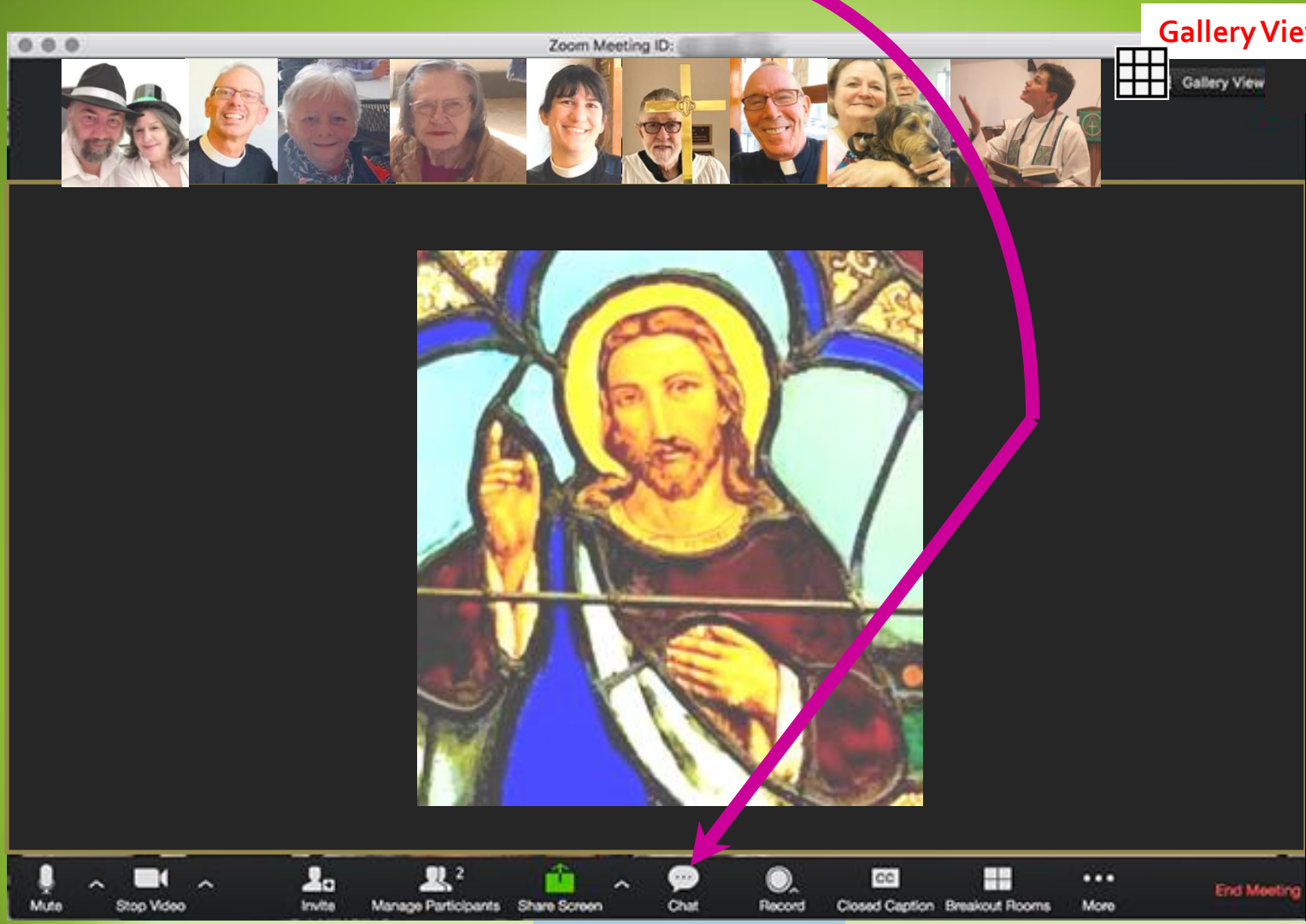
I believe in Jesus Christ, HIS only son, our Lord.




